## Fifth Course on International Humanitarian Law

The **Fifth Course on International Humanitarian Law** will take place on **Thursday January 26, 2012** at the headquarters of the Organization of American States: 1889 F St. NW, Washington, D.C. (Padilha Vidal room).

The course takes place pursuant to General Assembly resolutions AG/RES. 2575 (XL-O/10) and AG/RES. 2650 (XLI-O/11) on the "Promotion and Respect for International Humanitarian Law" which instruct the Permanent Council to organize the course through its Committee on Juridical and Political Affairs, with support of the Department of International Law of the General Secretariat and with the collaboration of the International Committee of the Red Cross.

**Languages:** The course will be held in English and Spanish, with simultaneous interpretation available in the four official languages of the Organization.

**Participation:** The course is open to staff of the permanent missions, staff of the General Secretariat, as well as for other interested persons.
