



DECRETO Nº 7.179, DE 20 DE MAIO DE 2010.

Institui o Plano Integrado de Enfrentamento ao Crack e outras Drogas, cria o seu Comitê Gestor, e dá outras providências.

O PRESIDENTE DA REPÚBLICA, no uso da atribuição que lhe confere o art. 84, inciso VI, alínea "a", da Constituição,

DECRETA:

Art. 1º Fica instituído o Plano Integrado de Enfrentamento ao Crack e outras Drogas, com vistas à prevenção do uso, ao tratamento e à reinserção social de usuários e ao enfrentamento do tráfico de crack e outras drogas ilícitas.

§ 1º As ações do Plano Integrado de Enfrentamento ao Crack e outras Drogas deverão ser executadas de forma descentralizada e integrada, por meio da conjugação de esforços entre a União, os Estados, o Distrito Federal e os Municípios, observadas a intersetorialidade, a





Integrated Plan Against Crack and Other Drugs

Objectives

- To structure, integrate, articulate and increase actions for the prevention of use, treatment and social re-integration of crack/drug users, including the participation of families and the attention to vulnerable populations;
- To structure, increase and strengthen health and social assistance networks devoted to crack/drug
 users through a better integration between the National Health System (SUS) and the National
 Social Assistance System (SUAS);
- To train, within a continuous basis, governmental and non-governmental actors involved with
 prevention, treatment and social re-integration actions related to crack/drug users, as well as that
 actors that fight drug trafficking;
- To promote and increase community participation in what concerns to policies and actions of prevention, treatmenta and social re-integration, encouraging the sharing of best practices;
- · To provide quality information about crack and other dugs; and
- To increase and strengthen actions to face drug trafficking.
