
Prevalence of Use in the General Population















Profile of Users in Treatment




Profile of Base Paste Users in Treatment

Data from information on users in treatment, 2010

I. Adult population:

4,410 people admitted to treatment for use of base paste as main drug, accounting for over 50% of admissions to treatment.

- Of which: 71% men and 29% women.
- Average age for both groups: 32 years.
- Marital status: 58% single; 34% living with a partner.
- 15% did not finish primary education; 26% did not finish secondary education.
- Employment status: 50% unemployed; 10% homemakers; 35% working.




Profile of Base Paste Users in Treatment




II. Young offenders

- 1,526 young offenders received treatment for the use of base paste as the main drug.
- 93.7% men, and only 6.3% women.
- Average age: 16 years, 10 months.
- Schooling: 55% did not finish primary education, and 18% have not finished secondary education.
