7. <u>Transfer (from/to airport)</u>

The National Council on Drugs (CND) will provide participants with transportation from/to the airport. Please send your itinerary to the persons listed in Section 4.

8. <u>Weather</u>

The Dominican Republic has a warm tropical climate. The average temperature throughout the year is 28C (82F).

Note: Formal attire is required for opening and closing of the event.
