

# **Demand Reduction Strategies**

- Global Youth Tobacco Initiative
  - Third round of GYTS completed in 2011
  - Data analysis in progress
  - Prison Population Survey (Relationship between drugs and crime)
  - Sponsored by CICAD
  - Data collection process completed in March 2012
  - Behaviour Risk Factor Survey
  - Data collection process: May August 2012
  - Attempt to include substance abuse issues into national disease surveillance activities


#### **Prevention and Treatment**

  - School lectures

  - World No Tobacco Day & International Day against Drug Abuse and Illicit Traficking
- Workplace Interventions

The Way Forward

• Timeframe: 2012-2017

- Highlight shared purpose/mission (Council's goals in relation to that of member agencies).
- Targeted policy to allow for better utilization of resources and more effective interventions.
- Respond to the requirement of **Articles of Convention and Treaties** to which Saint Lucia is a signatory.
