Ø PROMOTE THE DEVELOPMENT AND
ESTABLISHMENT OF NATIONAL
OBSERVATORIES ON DRUGS AND
THE USE OF STANDARDIZED DATA
AND METHODOLOGIES

OID FUNCTIONS (3)

Ø PROVIDE TECHNICAL AND SCIENTIFIC TRAINING FOR THE EXCHANGE OF EXPERIENCES AMONG THE PROFESSIONALS WORKING IN THE DRUG FIELD.

OID: PRINCIPAL PROGRAMS

- ø DEVELOPMENT AND STRENGTHENING OF NATIONAL OBSERVATORIES
- ø STUDIES AND RESEARCH (SIDUC)
- ø SUPPLY STATISTICS (CICDAT)
- ø "COST" STUDIES
- Ø DISSEMINATION OF INFORMATION
- ø COOPERATION AMONG OTHER AREAS OF CICAD: Demand Reduction, MEM, etc...

FUTURE PROJECTS: OBSERVATORIES

- ø EVALUATE CURRENT SITUATION OF EXISTING NATIONAL DRUG OBSERVATORIES,
- ø EVALUATE THE NEED FOR THE CREATION AND DEVELOPMENT OF LOCAL OBSERVATORIES IN MEMBER STATES.

FUTURE PROJECTS: OBSERVATORIES

- ø Disseminate the role of the National Observatories on Drugs:
 - q <u>SHOULD BE THE OFFICIAL AND RELIABLE</u> <u>SOURCE OF INFORMATION OF EACH COUNTRY.</u> <u>FOR THIS, IT SHOULD BE ABLE TO:</u>
 - q Generate, process and analyze information of interest, in a timely, reliable, and periodic manner
 - q Provide the decision-makers with information and proposals
 - a Access other sources of information

FUTURE PROJECTS: OBSERVATORIES

- ø Work with countries in the aspect of Human Resources:
 - Profile according to the functions of the National Observatories on Drugs
 - q Training according to their needs
 - qAlliances with Universities key to have access to new human resources

FUTURE PROJECTS: RESEARCH (SIDUC)

- ø Complete information on drug consumption in school population in countries that do not have updated information, principally the Caribbean.
- ø Explore data bases: Post-graduate degree thesis.
- ø Generate methodology to evaluate drug consumption in population at the University-level

FUTURE PROJECTS: RESEARCH (SIDUC)

Ø GIVE PRIORITY TO THE FOLLOWING STUDIES:

- q PERIODIC SCHOOL SURVEYS,
- q HOUSEHOLD SURVEYS IN COUNTRIES, AS NECESSARY,
- q CREATION OF A CONTINUOUS REGISTRY
 IN TREATMENT CENTERS AND LEGAL
 MEDICINE

FUTURE PROJECTS: CICDAT

- ø IMPLEMENTATION OF CICDAT SOFTWARE,
- ø TRAINING,
- ø USE CICDAT INFORMATION FOR COUNTRIES' RESPONSE TO MEM QUESTIONNAIRE.

FUTURE PROJECTS: COST STUDY

- Ø ADDITION OF NEW COUNTRIES TO THE COST STUDY, ACCORDING TO THE MANDATE OF THE 2005 SUMMIT.
- Ø EXTEND COVERAGE TO OTHER AREAS IN COUNTRIES THAT ARE ALREADY IN THE PROGRAM: AVOIDABLE COSTS, AND OTHERS.

FUTURE PROJECTS: International Relations

- ø FOSTER RELATIONSHIPS WITH OTHER INSTITUTIONS: UNODC, NIDA, EUROPEAN OBSERVATORY. ETC...
 - q OPTIMIZE FINANICAL RESOURCES,
 - q SAHRE DRUG-RELATED INFORMATION ON THE DIFFERENT COUNTRIES: MEM, ARQ, ETC...
 - q PRESENTATION OF JOINT PROJECTS.
