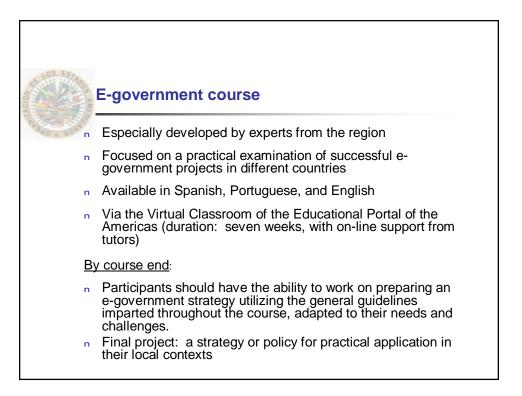




Distance e-government course

In response to the mandates and resolutions of the Summits of the Americas and other forums regarding the importance of incorporating information and communication technologies for institutional strengthening and better governance

A course designed with the central aim of ensuring that participants acquire knowledge of and master the main e-government concepts for the development of a strategy tailored to their own contexts



Course data

- Three open editions available to the general public in Spanish and one in English for the English-speaking Caribbean
- n English edition (participants from 11 Caribbean countries)
- n Special editions with Argentina, Brazil, Colombia, Costa Rica, Ecuador, and Mexico
- n MuNet program: Bolivia, El Salvador, Honduras, Nicaragua, Panama, Peru
- n Over 1,200 officials and academics trained throughout the region
- n Implementation of different projects of course participants
- n Cost: US\$150 per participant
