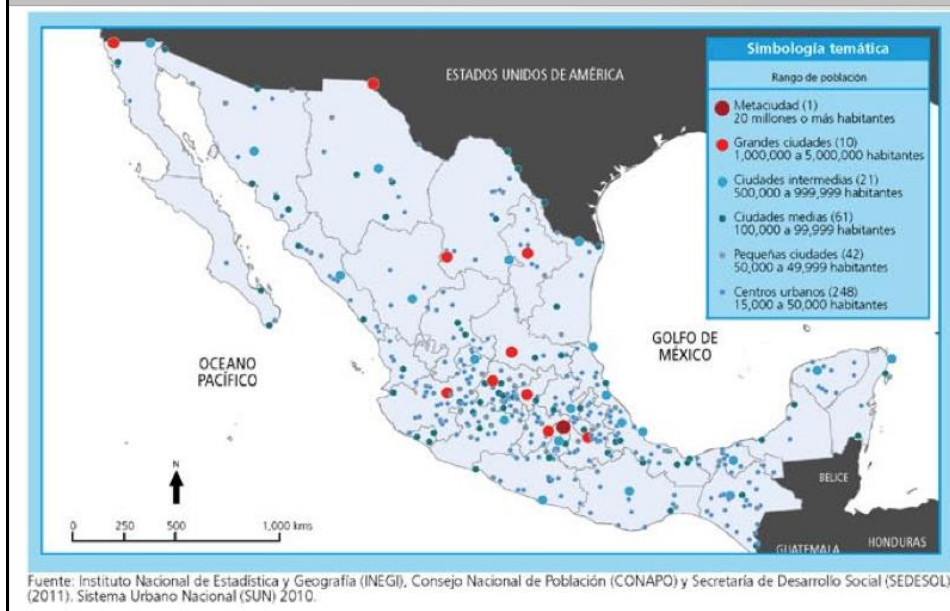


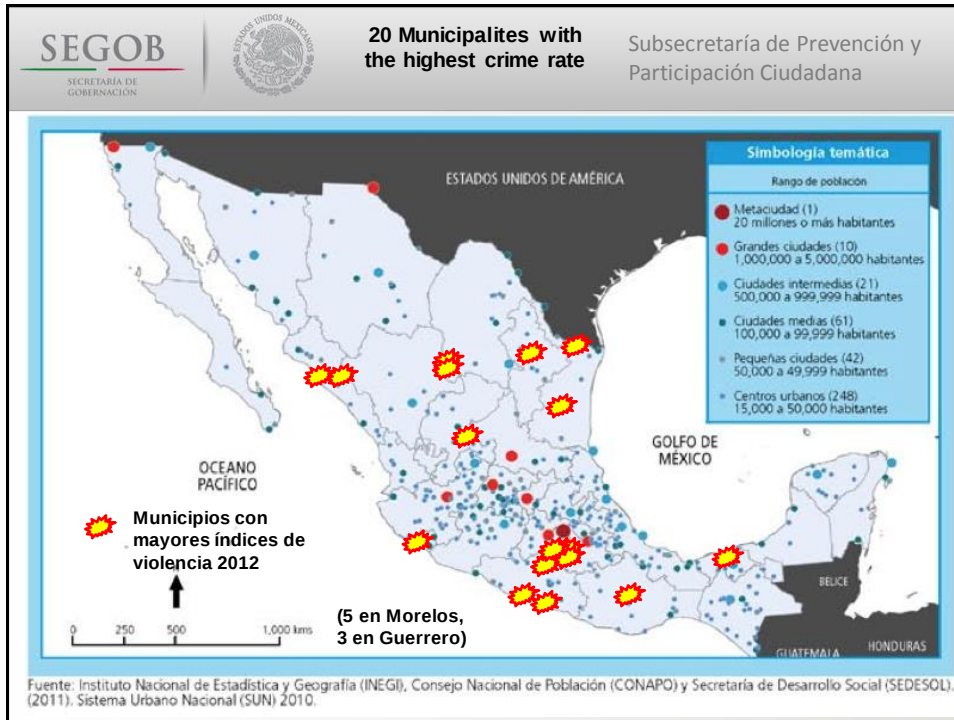


Hypothesis

- Violence and crime are more common in cities with low competitiveness, understood as little ability to attract and retain investment, either by its legal framework or the performance of its people.
- The phenomenon is not necessarily linked to poverty, but can be influenced by it.
- These are areas where there are not enough public services or support networks (kindergartens, schools, high-schools, hospitals).
- I.e.: Northern Border (after NAFTA), Touristic cities (Acapulco, Cuernavaca)

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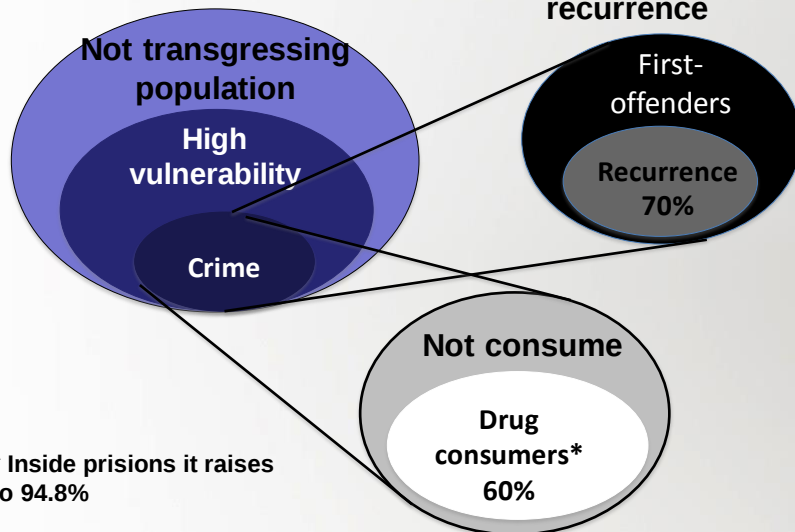
Crime and drug consumption

- 50% of non-serious crimes stems from alcohol abuse, 60% of serious crimes, alcohol and / or drugs.

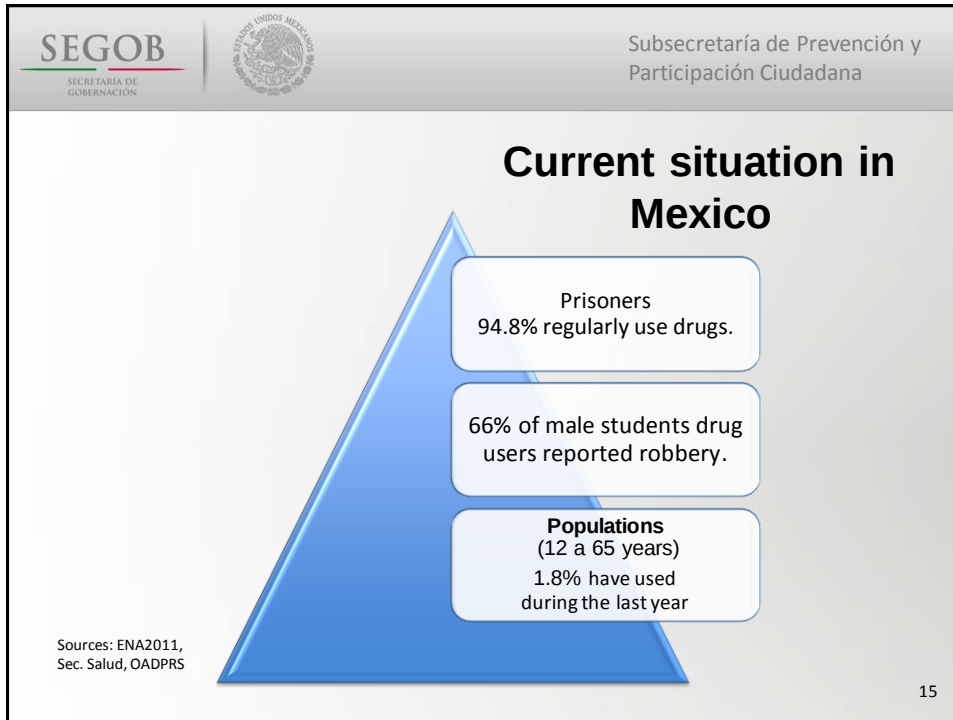

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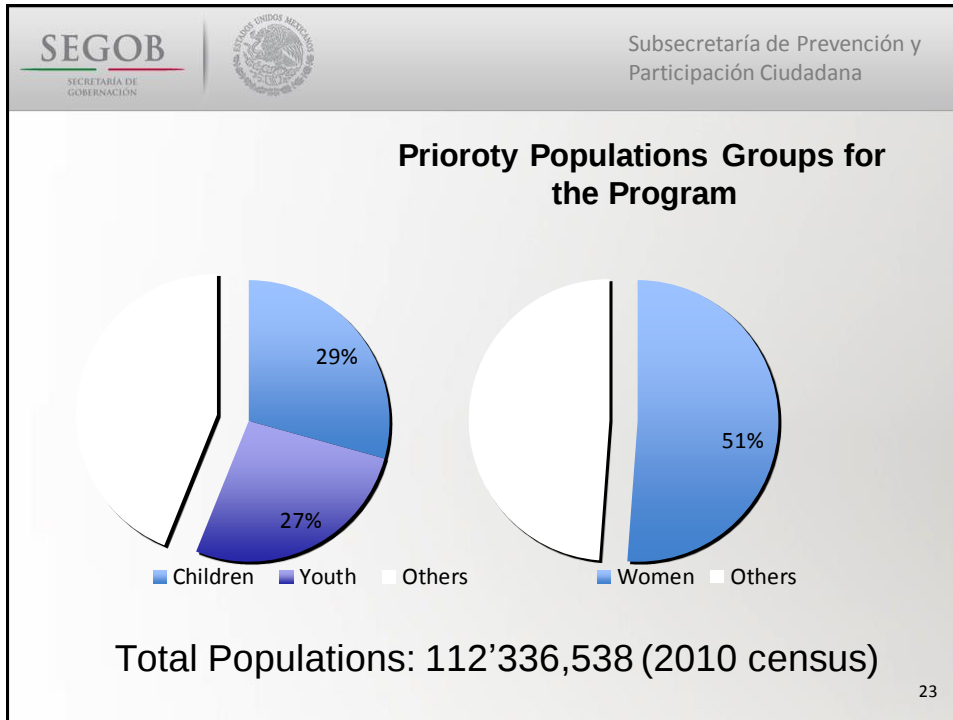

Social Prevention: Information

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Social Prevention: Regulation

- Smoke-free enclosed public spaces across the country.
- Limit hours of alcohol sale in convenience stores.
- Standardize nation-wide the operation and sanctions of the breathalyzer test.
- Proper application of restrictions on sales of alcohol to minors.

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Social Prevention: Drug Treatment Tribunals

- Create Drug Treatment Tribunals, at least one in every State.
- Generate a standard model of addiction treatment and rehabilitation support for DTT.
- Adapt specialized centers in different drugs, depending on their area of consumption.

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Perspective

- Track the start of the next generation in the consumption of addictive substances.
- Curb the casual consumer to become addicted.
- Prevent re-offending addict.
