STATUS OF THE DIN

- SHID is active. The Network has 8 regular member. The Observatory keep regular meeting With them. The are:

Recent Activities and Meeting

- The observatory did a qualitative interview with a key informant on drug abuse in the Country. This key Informant is the responsible of an NGO, called HEDO-HAITI (Haitian Educational and Development Organization).
- The Report of Drug situation in 2011 is being reviewed and will be publish in the next meeting of the SHID, planned and June
- No meetings for debating on drug problem has been held for now. The year meeting will take place June 19th and 20th.

Recent Activities and Meeting (cont'd)

- Meetings with institution (as APAAC, BLTS, and others...) for data collection were done this year.
- The observatory also participate on mission of the INCB (International Narcotics Control Board)in Haiti which aimed to assess the implementation of the three Conventions Drugs of the United Nations.
- The Observatory also, with the assistance of CICAD has started a survey in schools on drug consumption, but it has been postponed to assure success of the project.
- Finally, the observatory is involve, with the Demand Reduction in a starting project initiate by CADCA (American Anti Drug Coalition Community), which consist of prevention program based on community level

DATA TRENDS

 With respect to the findings of the qualitative survey with HEDO-HAITI, data claimed that amphetamine is used a lot in some region of the country, mostly in poor residential area or region outside of port-auprince. The results also indicate that other drugs such as MDMA (Ecstasy), benzodiazepine and methamphetamine are frequently used in the country.

DATA TRENDS (Cont'd)

Data collected in medical institution (as APAAC, Hospital of Beudet or Mars and Kline) shows that in 2012, people were here mostly for marijuana problem, followed by alcohol and cocaine. Some case of amphetamin abuser are also found.
