**Metanfetamina**  
(fenilmetilaminopropano; 1-fenil-2-metilaminopropano)

• Sintetizada en 1923 por el Doctor Nagasaki Nagai estudiado sobre efectos, uno de los ingredientes de Wu-Kuang (*Gubador japonés*) con resultado eficaz contra el asma y los reumatismos.  
• El polvo cristalino de metanfetamina recibe el nombre de "tallo o ice" y "velocidad o speed" y es capaz de alucinar en forma preponderante.  
• La metanfetamina o "ice" aparece por primera vez en Brasil a finales de la década de los años 80 y se ha extendido por la Costa Occidental. Recibió este nombre de "ice" por la apariencia de la droga como de trozos grandes de cristal claro.



Regional effects of the production and trafficking of Amphetamine-type substances : UNODC/PRELAC.

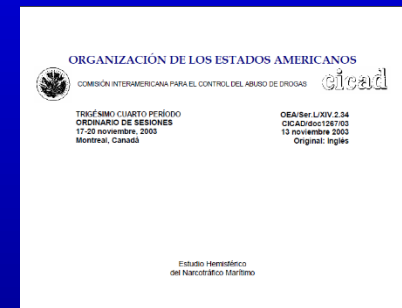

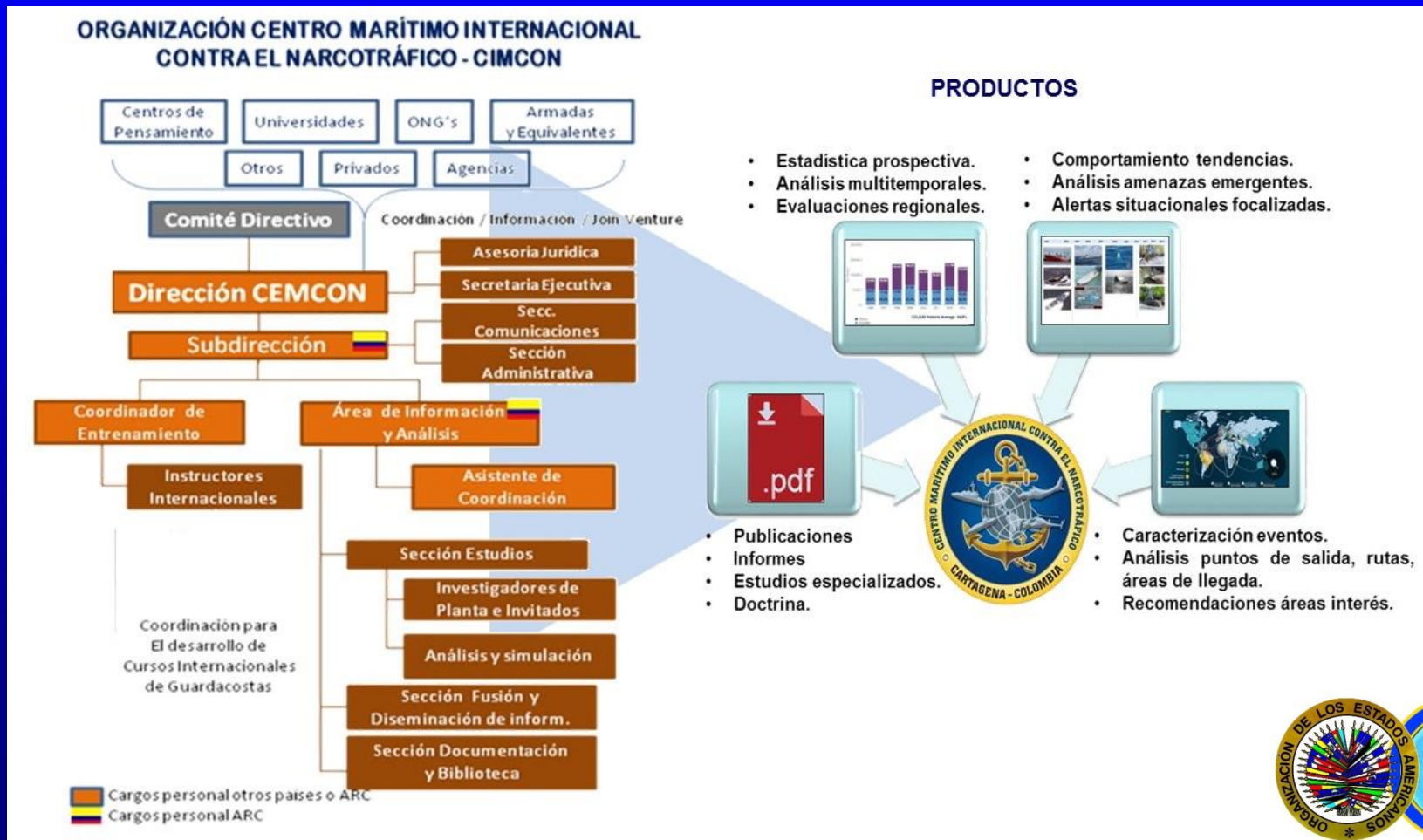

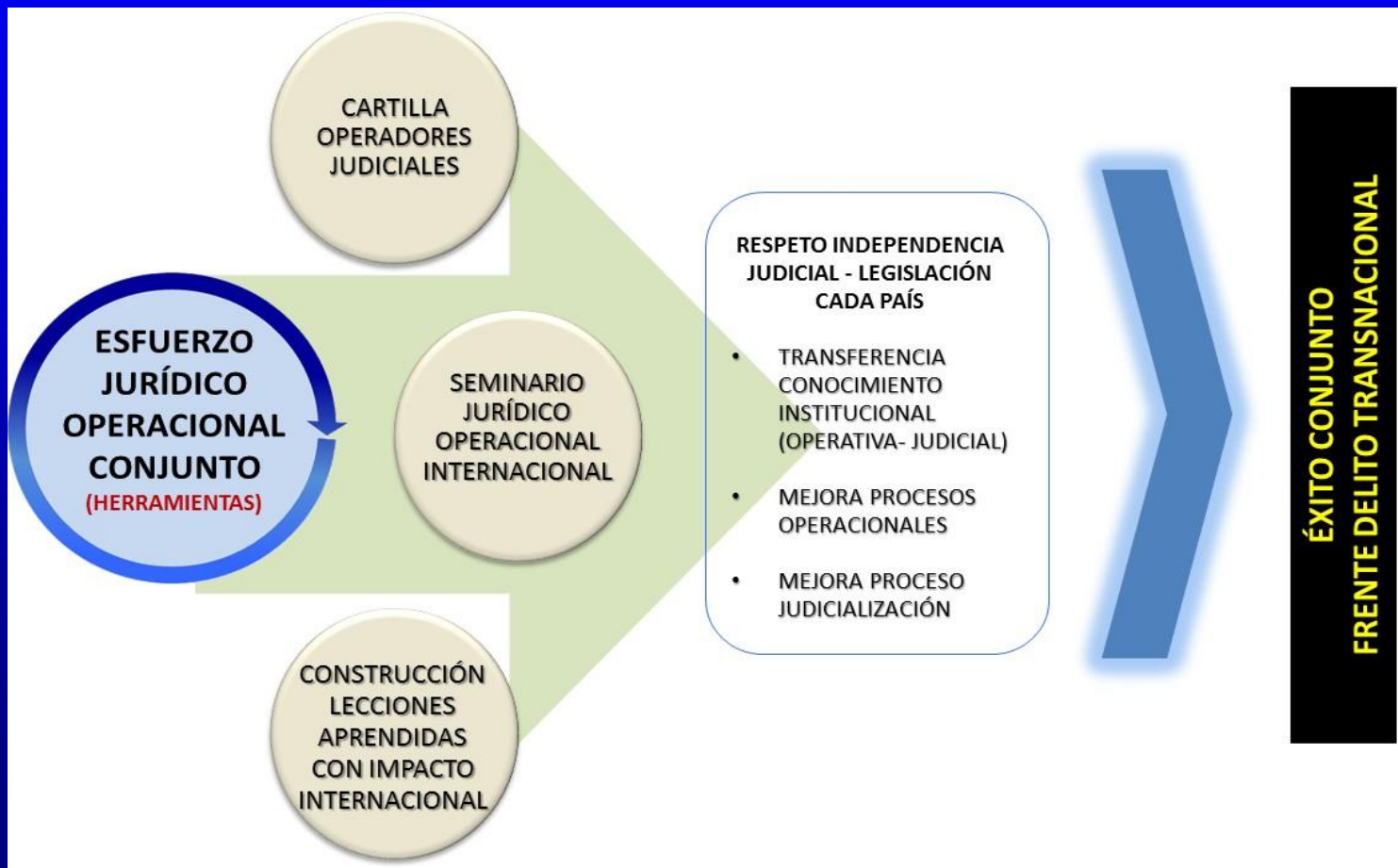
