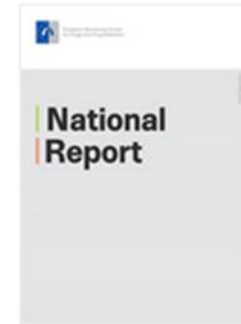

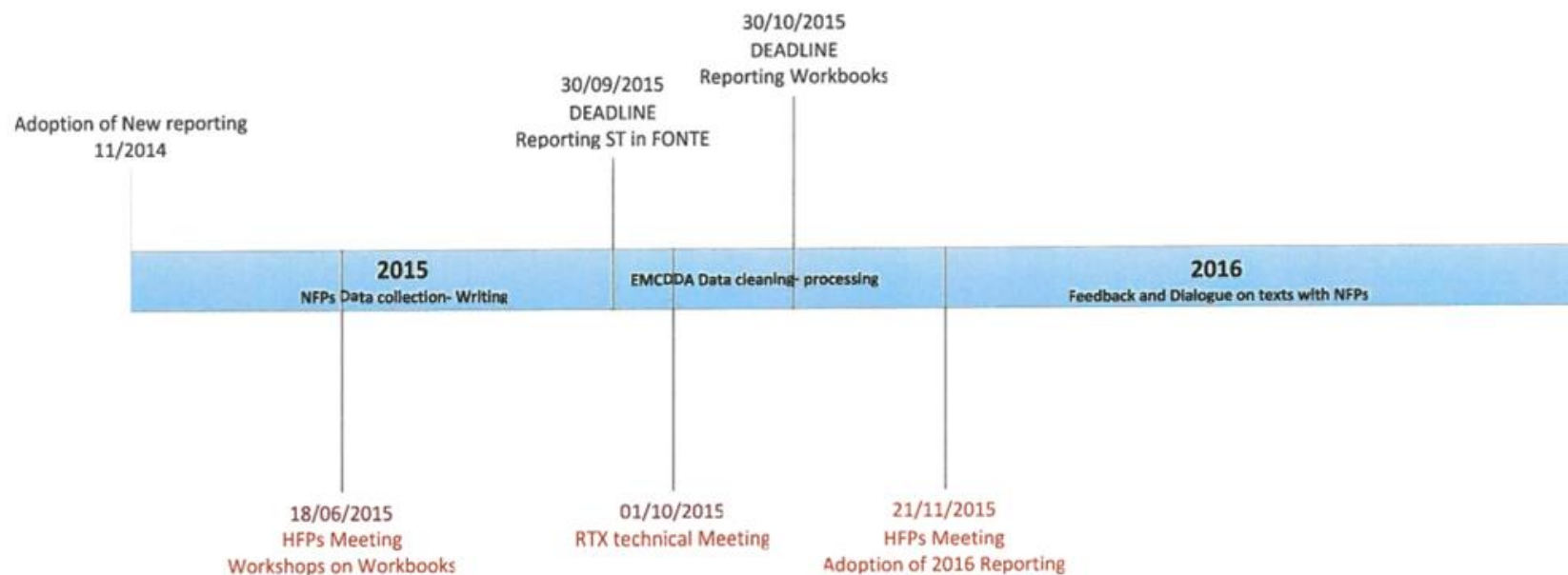

The Spanish national focal point is located within the Delegación del Gobierno para el Plan Nacional sobre Drogas, a government organisation under the auspices of the Ministry of Health and Consumer Affairs. The Delegación del Gobierno para el Plan Nacional sobre Drogas is entrusted with coordination of different aspects of drug policy, ranging from drug trafficking to responses to the drug problem.

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Situation summary, Spain
Country situation summaries are written with the general reader in mind and provide short, mainly text-based analyses of national drug situations.

Prevalence maps
These interactive maps show patterns of drug use throughout Europe. The data is broken down by type of drug and population.

National drug strategies, Spain
This resource provides access to the current national strategies and action plans for each country as well as a brief description of recent and ongoing work in the area.

Treatment profile, Spain
Each treatment profile provides information on the national context, treatment registries and monitoring systems, treatment demand, availability of treatment services as well as references and resources.

Public expenditure profiles, Spain
These data sheets on drug-related public expenditure cover 30 countries and examine how much countries spend on drug-related activities, whether there are specific budgets allocated to drug policy documents, and how drug-related expenditure has evolved over time.

Health and social responses profiles
How are countries responding to the drug situation in the area of health and social interventions? Find out with these interactive maps and timeline.

Prevention profile, Spain
What are countries in Europe doing to prevent illicit drug use? Prevention profiles attempt to answer this question using interactive maps and data charts based on expert appraisals.

Key data sheet, Spain
Key data sheets provide an at-a-glance statistical view of the drug situation by country and cover areas including prevalence, problem drug use, infectious diseases, deaths, and more.

Legal profile, Spain
Legal profiles describe national drug-related legislation in a standardised, comparable format. Topics covered include possession, trafficking, classification, production, prevention, treatment, among others.

Harm reduction overview, Spain
Each overview describes the national context, references and resources; key responses for preventing and reducing drug-related infectious diseases and drug-related harms in recreational settings.

Drug-related research, Spain
National drug related research provides information by country in the following areas: main funding frameworks, research institutions, scientific journals, websites, main studies conducted and articles published.

Tools to help:

- Information Map
- National Action Plan for drug information system (NAPDIS)



InfoMap: what do we have available?

Identifies all sources of drug-related information :

- that could be useful for the establishment of a national and regional data collection system on drugs, with special attention to Key Indicators
- with a focus on strengths and weaknesses of the data

InfoMap: description of databases

- Name contact details
- Objectives of database
- Statistical unit + definition
- Characteristics of population covered (variables)
- Geographical coverage
- Institutional coverage
- Coverage rate
- Inclusion & exclusion criteria
- Sampling procedure

InfoMap: description of databases

- Substances
- Data gathering methodology
- Data storage
- Software for data processing
- Level of aggregation of information
- Legal status of database
- Legal status of aggregated data
- Time period : 1st and last year available
- Evaluation of data quality and reliability

InfoMap: description of databases

- Comments
- Abstract or ex of data output
- Bibliography-website
- Annexes

NAPDIS: document officially adopted
