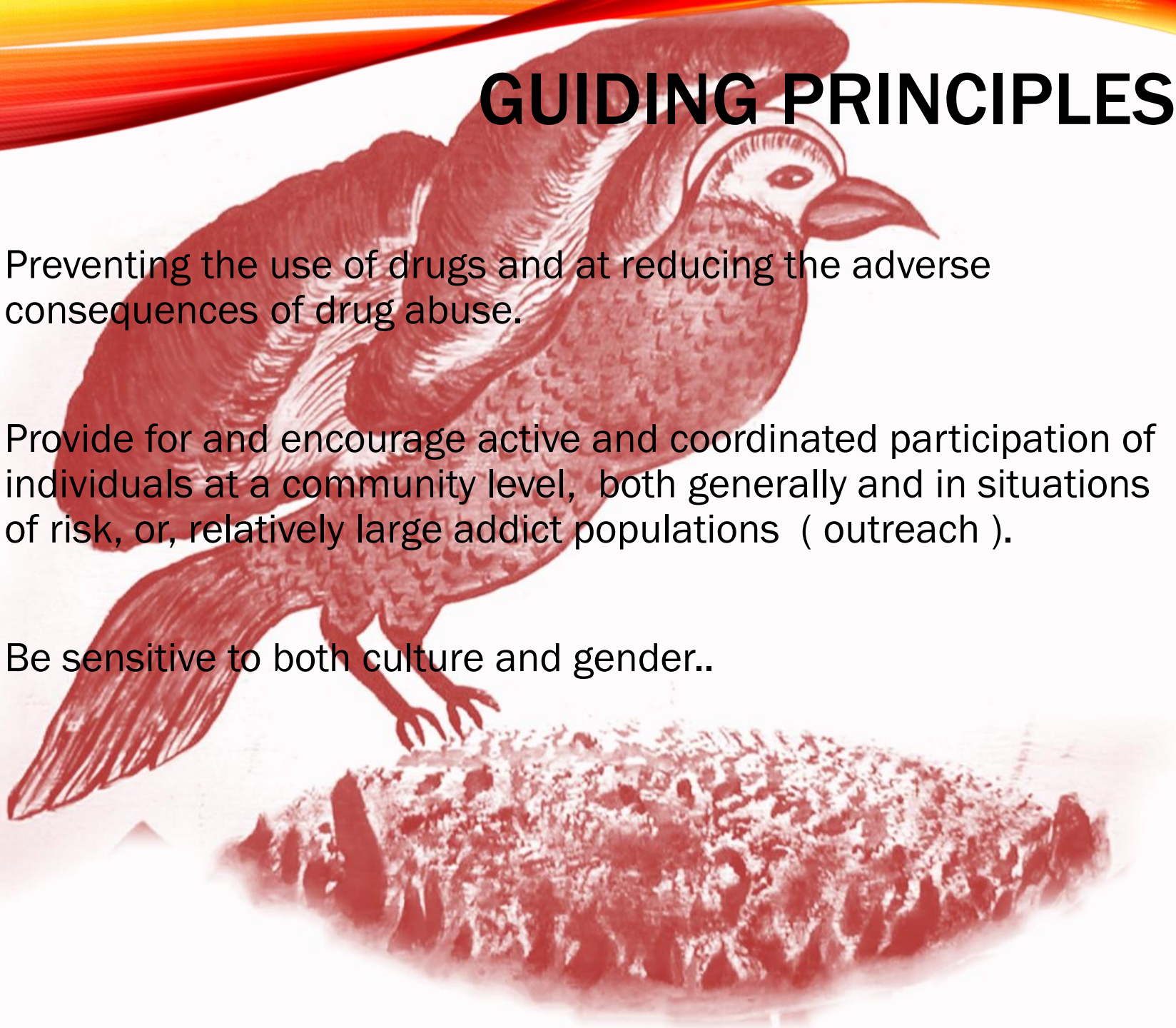


OBJECTIVES

- TO ENABLE THE INDIVIDUAL TO BE REINTEGRATED

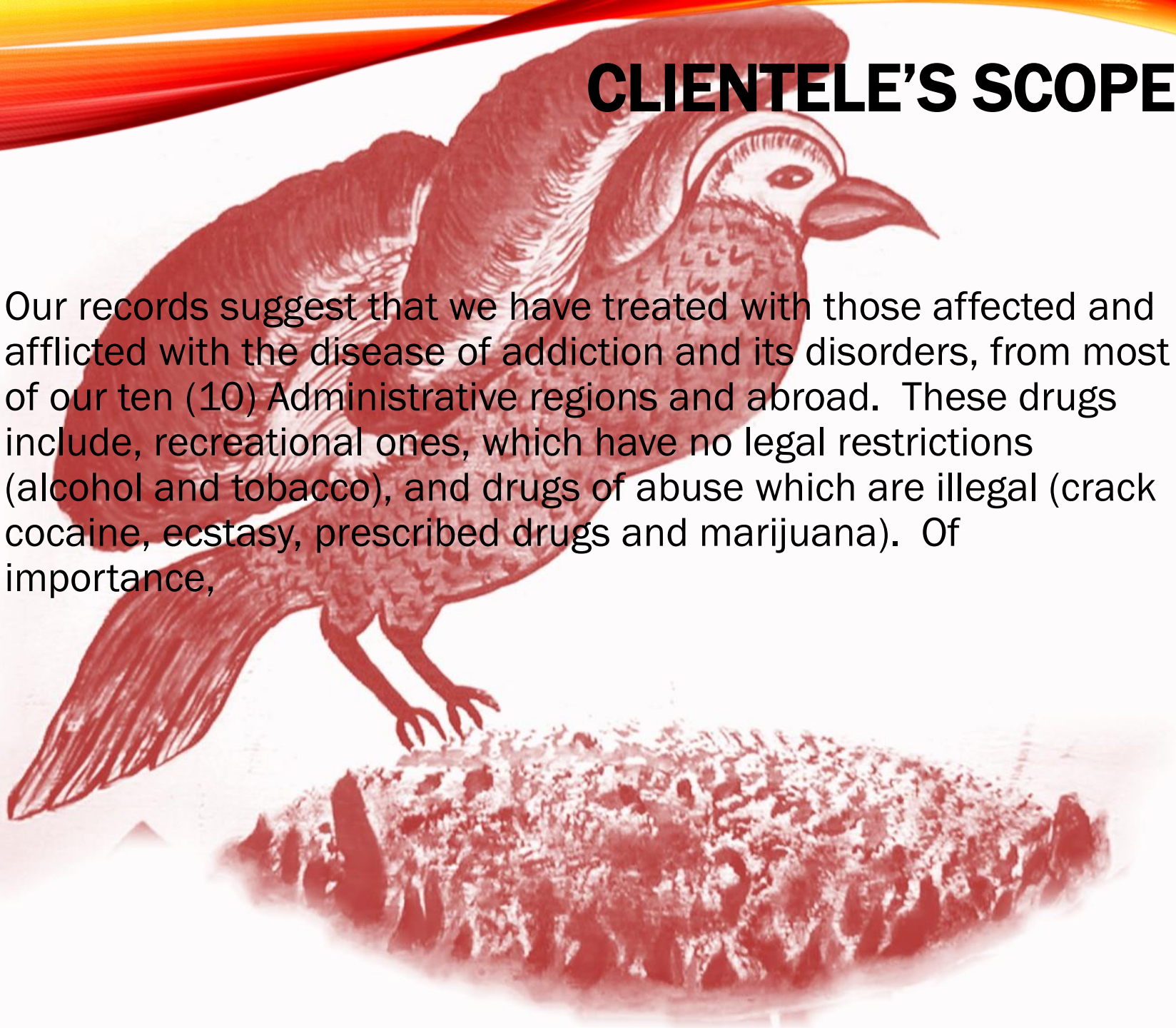
GUIDING PRINCIPLES

- Preventing the use of drugs and at reducing the adverse consequences of drug abuse.
- Provide for and encourage active and coordinated participation of individuals at a community level, both generally and in situations of risk, or, relatively large addict populations (outreach).
- Be sensitive to both culture and gender..



CLIENTELE'S SCOPE

- Our records suggest that we have treated with those affected and afflicted with the disease of addiction and its disorders, from most of our ten (10) Administrative regions and abroad. These drugs include, recreational ones, which have no legal restrictions (alcohol and tobacco), and drugs of abuse which are illegal (crack cocaine, ecstasy, prescribed drugs and marijuana). Of importance,



- however, substance abuse does not only imply a particular type of drug, but the extent to which the drug is used/abused and , of course, its effects, emotionally, behaviorally and mentally on the addict.

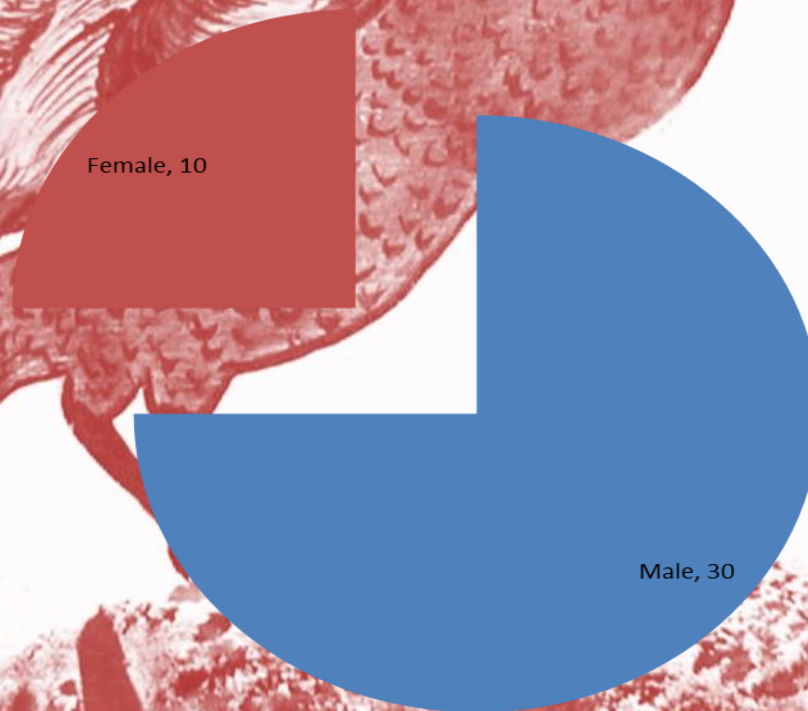

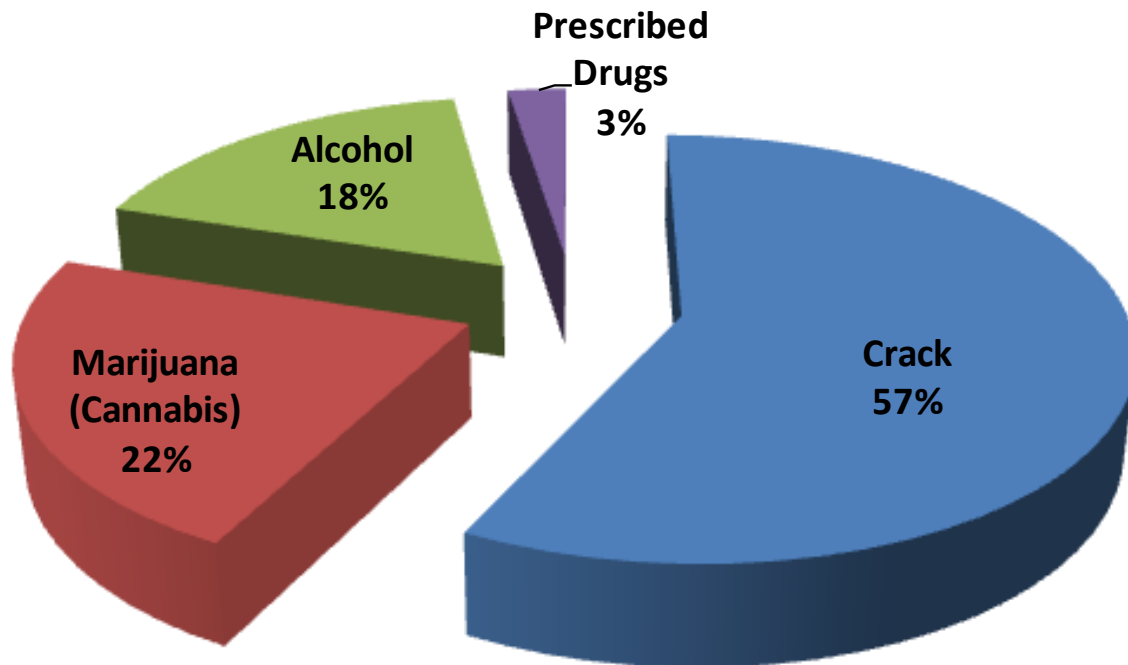
DISTRIBUTION OF PERSONS TREATED AT PHOENIX RECOVERY PROJECT BY GENDER
