- Secondary School Drug Education Curriculum
  - Drug education curriculum revamped taking into account the survey's findings
  - Curriculum was piloted in 4 secondary schools
  - ▶ Pilot completed and the plan is to extend the curriculum to additional schools in the upcoming school year (September 2016)
  - Pilot curriculum will help to develop standardized approaches to drug education across primary, secondary and tertiary students e.g. curriculum development, delivery and assessment

## Policy Initiatives

- The findings were incorporated into the recently approved Barbados National Anti-Drug Plan (BNADP)
- ► The findings assisted in the policy discussion on the legalization/decriminalization of Marijuana
- Presentations have been made to local policy makers e.g. Joint Meeting of Cabinet Committees on Social Policy and Governance
