REGIONAL FUSION CENTERS MODEL: OPERATION, DESIGN, IMPLEMENTATION



The concept of "need to share" requires agencies of the different concerned countries to exchange information through centralized mechanisms.

The regional picture demands the unification of strategies among states and organizations fighting against the threat in order to promote new strategies and strengthen existing ones.

Implementation of Fusion Centers from Information Centers that already exist in the region, providing them with the ability to perform fusion functions and integration of information allowing it to be reliable, complete and flow expeditiously.

THE JUDICIAL PROCESS AS A KEY FACTOR IN OPERATIONAL OUTCOMES



Provide tools to judicial authorities, in order to achieve success in the prosecution of cases against maritime drug trafficking.



Highlight the importance of judicial authorities to know and understand the maritime operational environment for the development of actions against drug trafficking.



Apply Operational Procedure in the context of national and international law, including Human Rights and International Humanitarian Law applicable to every state in operational actions in the fight against drug trafficking in the maritime scenario.

CONCLUSIONS AND RECOMMENDATIONS



Approve "A guide for the judicial system agencies involved in prosecuting drug cases to develop Legal and Operational Seminars".

Direct the Group of Experts to meet in 2017 and implement the proposed plan of action, allowing for the consideration of new or emerging issues.

COMISSION

Information Document on Fusion Centers in the Region as a contribution in the fight against drug trafficking.

Instruct the Expert Group at the next meeting to update the problem of illicit drug trafficking through riverine systems and common border waterways to determine variables and commonalities for member sates to use in the fight against such method of trafficking.
