


## ST VINCENT AND THE GRENADINES

### Justification:

- GEG unable to conduct an evaluation of the country's implementation of the Third Evaluation Round recommendations.
- Saint Vincent and the Grenadines did not provide the necessary information.
- Objective - to discuss with government officials and other stakeholders in drug control, the obstacles that have been impeding the authorities' adequate compliance with the requirements of the Third Evaluation Round of the Multilateral Evaluation Mechanism.
