Creation of coordination mechanisms between the agencies with incumbency in drug policy.


Change of the name of Sedronar: Secretary of Comprehensive Policies on Drugs of the Argentina Nation.

Development of a new national drug demand reduction plan






#### **National Plan: guiding principles**

## National drugs policies and the exchange with provinces and municipalities (I)

Federal Drugs
Council
(COFEDRO)

- A forum for dialogue, exchange and creation of consensus between national and provincial administrations in a federal environment.
- Strengthening and sustainability of a joint agenda.

PROGRAM
MUNICIPALITIES IN
ACTION

- Transfer of capacities between nation and municipalities.
- Promotion and creation of offices for drug related problems in the municipalities.
- Development of drug plans at the local level
- 515 municipalities reached.





## National drugs policies and the exchange with provinces and municipalities (II)

EXPERIENCES OF COMMUNITY TREATMENT

- 25 experiences of Community Treatment.
- Buenos Aires (9), Córdoba (2), Corrientes (1), Entre Ríos (1), Jujuy (2), La Pampa (1), Mendoza (3), Misiones (1), Salta (1), Santa Fe (1), Santiago del Estero (1), Tierra del Fuego (1), Tucumán (1)
- Intervention model that coordinates the community and institutional networks.

COMPREHENSIVE CENTERS FOR TERRITORIAL APPROACH (DIAT)

- 73 DIAT.
- Centers managed by Sedronar in 20 provinces
- Community based centers for the promotion and restitution of rights.





## National drugs policies and the exchange with provinces and municipalities (III)

COMPREHENSIVE PREVENTION POLICIES

- Education, deprivation of liberty, arts, sports, working, night-time, vulnerable environments.
- Training courses for different areas and services of public health system, judiciary and for degrees on comprehensive approaches of problematic drug use.

COMMUNITY BASED CARE AND SUPPORT PREMISES (CAAC)

- Community based low threshold centers in high level of vulnerability contexts.
- Agreements with Civil Society Organizations.
- 65 CAAC.





# National drugs policies and the exchange with provinces and municipalities (IV)

DRUGS
MONITORING
CENTER OF
ARGENTINA


- Household national study designed with statistical representation for each province in order to produce data useful at the local level.
- Strengthening of the provincial drugs monitoring centers
- Early Warning System.
- Community epidemiological surveillance in primary health care centers and mid school system in coordination with provinces (Next months).

QUALITY CRITERIA

- COPOLAD quality criteria for drug treatment centers.
- Activities with drug treatment centers for the incorporation of quality criteria.
- Participation in the pilot exercise of quality criteria.













#### Remarks

- Commitment of the Government of Argentina for the development of a decentralized drugs policy with strong component in local participation.
- A challenge in the **strengthening of the capacities** of the provinces and municipalities for the implementation of their **own local drugs policies**.
- Conviction in the importance of **creating scientific evidence** in public policies, including the provincial and municipal level.
- Generation of social and healthcare networks in the provincial and municipal levels for the support of the most in need populations.
- Promotion of the coordination between the stakeholders on drug policies in different jurisdictions.
