- To achieve health, a multisector approach must be adopted to act on the **social, environmental and economic determinants of health**, with a view to reducing health inequities and enabling sustainable development.

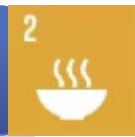

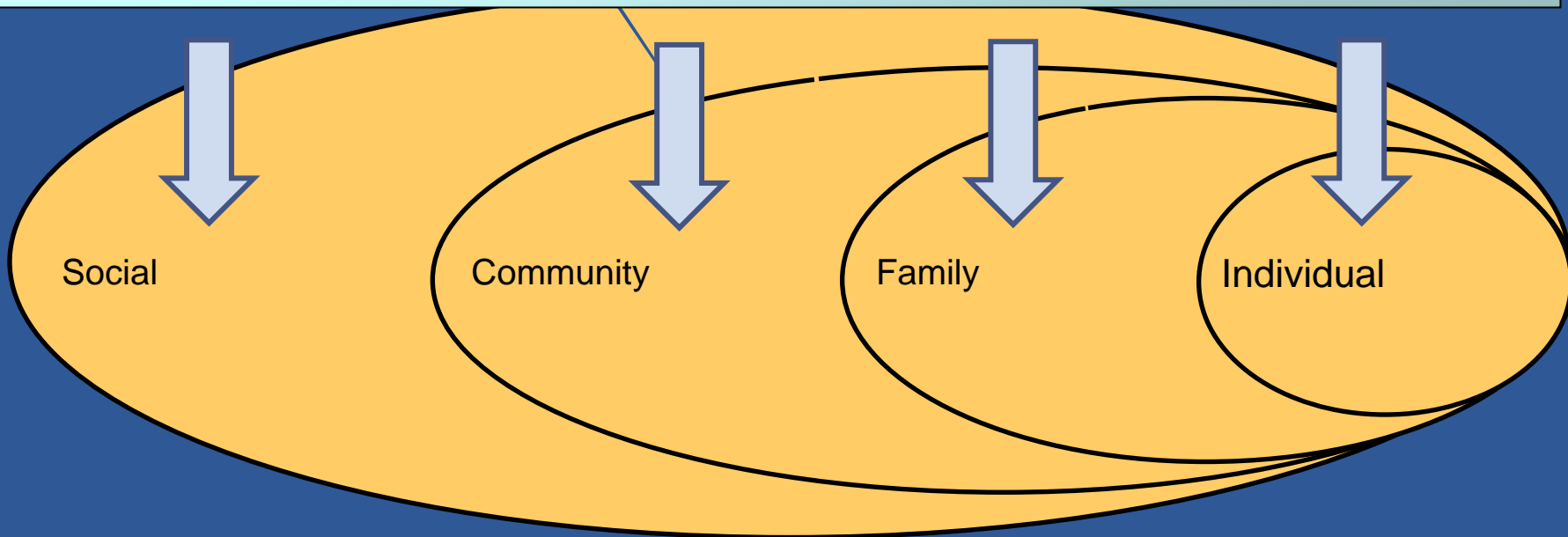


Public health perspective - Ecological model



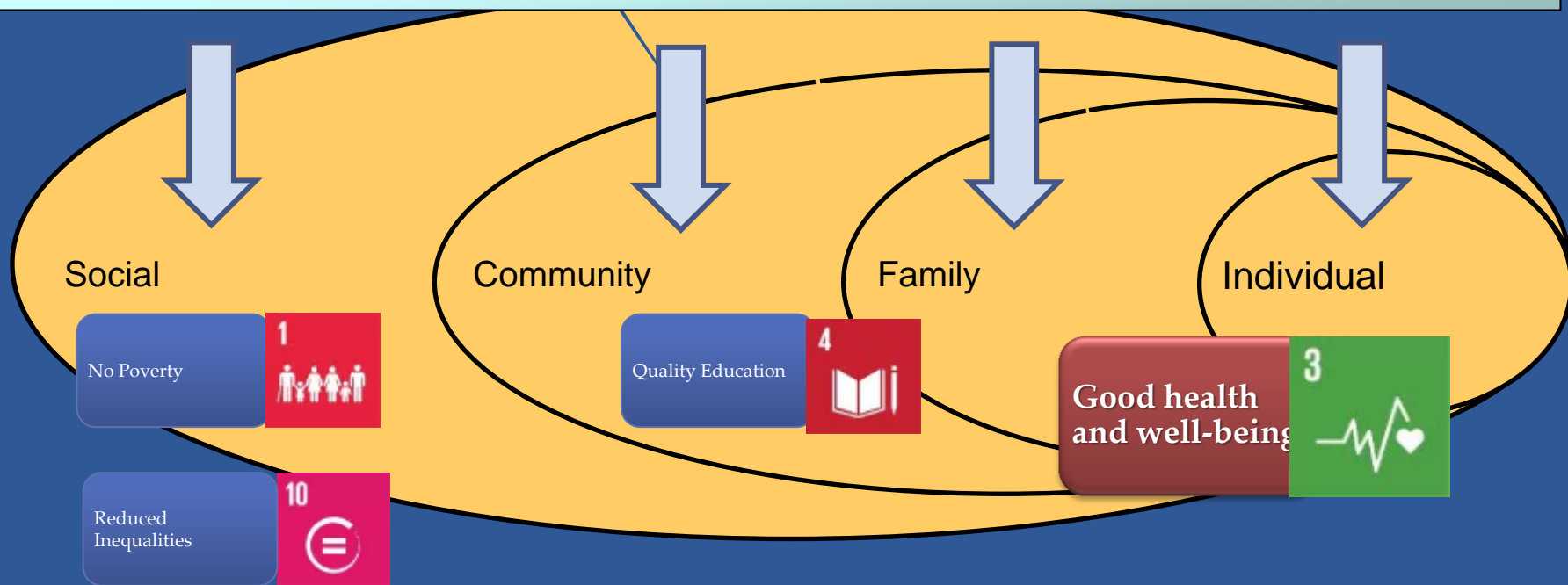
Public health perspective - Ecological model

The change of attention focus from individual drug consumption to action on social determinants and risk factors to diminish individual and collective vulnerability is the basis of the public health approach



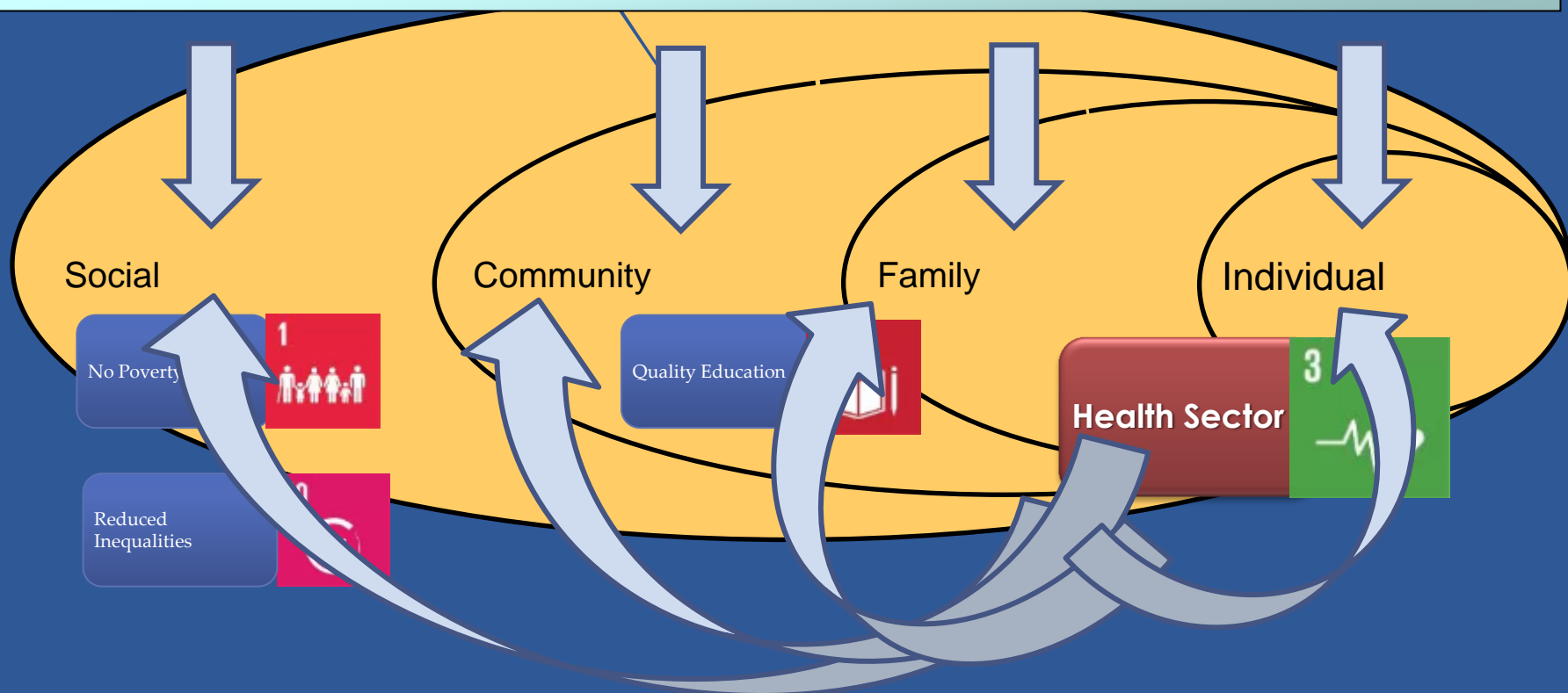
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Universal health coverage
