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Since its conception, DEA has maintained formal and informal relations with regulated industry to insure their participation in the development of laws, rules, and regulations affecting them.

DEA's intent is not to impact and disrupt legitimate industry and commerce, but to target illicit activity.




The cooperation of the regulated industry is preferable to their antagonism: we can accomplish more as partners than as adversaries.



Establishing and fostering the concept that regulated industry is a welcome partner in the control of precursor chemicals and synthetic substances.





Publication of guides, opinions, and interpretations of laws, rules, and regulations for the benefit of regulated industry.

As requested by the regulated industry, participating in seminars and conferences to explain DEA's views and positions on matters of interest.



Establishing specific contact points to effectively handle regulated industry inquiries, and to insure easy access to publications and clarifications of DEA's views and positions.



Separation and DEA 'website' on the internet to facilitate access to information.



A Hosting conferences and seminars to maintain an open dialogue with regulated industry; interpreting rules and regulations (old and new); and explaining administrative and civil changes.





Establishing a 24-hour call site to respond to inquiries, complaints, and requests by regulated industry.

A Training of specialists in registration matters who are accessible during normal working hours.



National With the assistance, collaboration, and cooperation of regulated industry, updating and modifying chemical legislation, based on their opinion and

advice.
