


OVER PRESCRIPTION & DIVERSION

- Increased prescribing of opioids and diversion leading to abuse, initially in high income countries
- Use of licitly manufactured opioids increased steadily over past 20 years (3x)
- Fentanyl use increased exponentially (graph)
- Illicit markets expanded to fill synthetic opioids demand as of 2013 (deadly illicit fentanyls)

MORE NPS, MORE DEADLY




Fentanyls are a cheap added to heroin, cocaine and falsified pills sold as medication

Inconsistent mixing lead to overdose for unsuspecting user.

Overdose may also result from improper handling by officers, K9 units etc.




FENTANYL, **FATAL UNDER 2mg**







- Analysis of 1.5M trades over 2 months from: AB, Hansa, Traderoute, Valhalla (June –July 2017)
- Top 5 countries account for more than 70% of global trade: USA (27%), UK (22%), Germany (8%), Australia (8%), and Holland (7%)
- Darkweb trade of opioids largely independent of both national production and consumption— it's a global marketplace



NUMBER OF SYNTHETIC OPIOID DEATHS AND FENTANYL EXHIBITS BY YEAR, 2011-2016




- +117% increase in identifications in 2017 (over 2016); 18 different synthetic opioids seized
- Entering USA via China (chemicals via post) and Mexico (fake preparations via land border)

2017, BY PROVINCE




- 2017, Canada overdose rate increased to 10.6 opioids-related deaths per 100,000

OPIOIDS IN AFRICA AND NEAR/ MIDDLE EAST

Alarming quantities of unregistered/ fraudulent **tramadol** at 120 mg, 225 mg, 250 mg strengths found throughout Near/ Middle East and Africa.

Tramadol abuse in Ghana became an issue of interest when in 2016, when intelligence gathered across the country pointed to scattered incidences.





