4. Languages and Documents

All working sessions will be in the four official languages of the Organization: Spanish, French, English and Portuguese. There will be simultaneous interpretation in these languages. Documentation for the meeting will be posted on the <u>CICAD webpage</u>. To maintain eco-friendly meetings, printed documents will be limited.

5. Entry Requirements

The United States Government requires travelers to present a passport, which must have a minimum validity of six months, and a copy of the round-trip ticket. Also, all foreign citizens (except those whose countries are members of the Waiver Program traveling only with a valid passport) need a valid visa to enter the United States. Without the appropriate visa, the immigration service will not allow entry to U.S. territory.

It is recommended that participants check early with the U.S. embassy or consulate in their countries about visa requirements enter the United States. For more information visit the website: http://www.travel.state.gov
