People died every day from opioid-related drug overdoses



11.5 m People misused prescription opioids¹



42,249
People died from overdosing on opioids²



2.1 million
People misused prescription
opioids for the first time¹

People had an opioid use
disorder¹



17,087
Deaths attributed to overdosing on commonly prescribed opioids²



948,000 People used heroin¹



19,413
Deaths attributed to overdosing on synthetic opioids other than methadone²



170,000 People used heroin for the first time¹




15,469 Deaths attributed to overdosing on heroin²


Overdose Deaths in Washington DC




Creating A Coordinated Response


