MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING

BETWEEN

THE FLORIDA INTERNATIONAL UNIVERSITY

BOARD OF TRUSTEES

AND

THE GENERAL SECRETARIAT OF THE ORGANIZATION OF AMERICAN STATES

THROUGH ITS

DEPARTMENT FOR DEMOCRATIC AND POLITICAL AFFAIRS FOR THE SPECIAL PROGRAM FOR THE PROMOTION OF DIALOGUE AND CONFLICT RESOLUTION

The Parties to this Memorandum of Understanding ("MOU") are The Florida International University Board of Trustees ("FIU"), on behalf of the Florida International University Latin American and Caribbean Center ("LACC"), and the General Secretariat of the Organization of American States ("SG/OAS"), through the Department for Democratic and Political Affairs ("DPA").

Whereas the DPA operates the Special Program for the Promotion of Dialogue and Conflict Resolution and FIU is interested in cooperating with that Program with a view to developing a variety of joint initiatives and capacity building activities.

ARTICLE I: PURPOSE

1.1 The Purpose of this MOU is to provide the basic framework for developing between the Parties a long-term, flexible collaborative relationship responsive to the needs of the FIU academic community and OAS member states in the area of

conflict prevention and resolution.

ARTICLE II: AREAS OF COLLABORATION

- 2.1 The initial collaboration between the Parties will consist of joint initiatives in three principal areas:
 - a) The design and delivery of a workshop for political party leaders in Latin

 America and the Caribbean in dialogue and conflict prevention;
 - b) The development of a conflict vulnerability assessment tool for policymaking purposes; and
 - c) The design of a training curriculum on how to use the conflict vulnerability assessment framework targeted to key figures in OAS member states as well as those interested in the FIU academic community.
- 2.2 All specific projects and activities jointly undertaken by the Parties shall not initiate without a special project agreement signed by the Parties. Each special project agreement shall include, at a minimum, the responsibilities of the parties with regard to project funding, reporting, and implementation, together with dates of commencement, termination, and coordination.

ARTICLE III: REPRESENTATION AND NOTICE

- 3.3 Either Party may change its representative appointed under this Article by written notice to the other.
- 3.4 Notice required under this Agreement must be sent from and received at the corresponding addresses or E-mail addresses specified above or as modified in accordance with Article 3.3.

ARTICLE IV: MISCELLANIOUS CONDITIONS

4.1 The Parties shall seek to resolve any dispute between them arising under this MOU through discussions between them. If those discussions prove unsuccessful, then either Party may submit the matter to binding arbitration in accordance with the Arbitration Rules of the United Nations Trade Commission on International Law ("UNCITRAL"), the American Arbitration Association, or such other rules as they may otherwise agree. There shall be three arbitrators, who may decide the dispute as amiable compositeur or ex aequo ex bono; and the language of the arbitration shall be English. The place of the arbitration shall be selected by the Parties; however, if the Parties cannot agree on the Place, the arbitrators shall select it from among the cities where each of the Parties has its principal headquarters. Nothing in this Agreement constitutes a waiver,

express or implied, of the privileges and immunities of the Parties, their agents, their principals, and their employees. This Section 5.1 shall survive the termination of this Agreement.

- 4.2 The Parties may modify or otherwise amend this MOU by way of a written instrument signed by both, dated, and attached hereto.
- 4.3 This MOU shall enter into force immediately once it has been signed by both Parties and it shall remain in force indefinitely, Either Party may terminate this MOU by giving sixty day's advanced written notice to the other. Both Parties may agree to terminate this MOU according to whatever terms they may agree.
- 4.4 The termination of this MOU shall not necessarily require the termination of any special project or activity covered by a Special Project Agreement then in force.
