ADDENDUM NUMBER ONE

TO THE

MAY 2006 PROJECT AGREEMENT

BETWEEN

**THE GENERAL SECRETARIAT OF THE ORGANIZATION OF AMERICAN STATES,
THROUGH THE DEPARTMENT OF SUSTAINABLE DEVELOPMENT**

AND

THE INSTITUTE OF JAMAICA

TO

“IMPLEMENT, UPDATE AND MAINTAIN AN I3N IAS DATABASE IN JAMAICA”

WHEREAS:

That, In May, 2006, the General Secretariat of the Organization of American States, (hereinafter referred to as “GS/OAS”) and The Institute of Jamaica (hereinafter referred to as the “Institution”) (hereinafter collectively referred to as the “Parties”) entered into a Project Agreement (hereinafter referred to as the “MAY 2006 Project Agreement”) to “Implement, Update and Maintain an I3N IAS DataBase in Jamaica;” and

That Paragraphs 13.1 and 13.2 of the MAY 2006 Project Agreement provide for amendment of that Agreement by the Parties

WHEREFORE, the Parties hereby agree as follows:



1. This Addendum Number One between the Institute of Jamaica and the General Secretariat of the Organization of American States shall be appended to and shall be governed by, the terms set out in the MAY 2006 Project Agreement

2. Nothing in this Addendum Number One shall be construed as modifying any of the terms and conditions agreed to by the Parties in the MAY 2006 Project Agreement except as specifically set forth in this Addendum Number One.

3. The provisions indicated below of the MAY 2006 Project Agreement are hereby amended, as follows:

Article IV

3.1 Paragraph 4.2 of the MAY 2006 Project Agreement is amended to read as follows:

“4.2. The institution shall submit a final technical-financial report, in digital version in accordance with Article 1.1 and 1.2, above, including a total of 80 invasive species with at least 100 validated records by subject experts and final version of 3 posters and 2 brochures on invasive species in Jamaica adopting I3N standards (the “Final Report”). The Final Report, including digital copy of the I3N IAS Database in Jamaica, shall be received no later than August 31, 2007. Within thirty days following its receipt of the Final Report, GS/OAS shall review it and notify the Institution in writing that it is either satisfactory or unsatisfactory. If the Report is unsatisfactory, GS/OAS shall further notify the Institution in writing of what the Institution must do to make the Report satisfactory and the Institution shall have another thirty days to do so from the date it receives that notice.

Article XII

3.2 Section 12.2 (ii) of the MAY 2006 Project Agreement is amended to read as follows:
