**AMENDMENT NO. 1 TO THE
AGREEMENT DATED JANUARY 22, 2002,

The Parties, the General Secretariat of the Organization of American States (“GS/OAS”), through its Department of Human Development (“DHD”) of the Secretariat for Integral Development (“SEDI”), and the University of South Florida (“USF”),

CONSIDERING:

The Agreement between the General Secretariat of the Organization of American States (“GS/OAS”) through the Inter American Agency for Cooperation and Development (“IACD”), and the University of South Florida (“USF”), signed on January 22, 2002;

Article VII 4. of the above-referenced Agreement which provides for its amendment by the duly authorized representatives of the Parties; and

The reorganization of the GS/OAS pursuant to Executive Order 05-13 Rev. 4 pursuant to which the administration of the OAS Scholarship and Training Programs is assigned to the Department of Human Development of the Secretariat for Integral Development,

HEREBY AGREE:

1. To revive the January 22, 2002 Agreement (the “2002 Agreement” or the “Agreement”) between the General Secretariat of the Organization of American States (“GS/OAS”) through and for the Inter-American Agency for Cooperation and Development and the University of South Florida for the Americas Leadership Fellowship Program “Alberto Lleras” which pursuant to Article VII 1. had provided that the Agreement would expire five years after the date that it was signed by both parties; and,

2. To amend the revived Agreement pursuant to Article VII.4 thereof, as follows:

(a) To replace, throughout the 2002 Agreement, each of the references to the Inter-American Agency for Cooperation and Development (“IACD”), with references to the Department of Human Development (“DHD”) of the Secretariat for Integral Development (“SEDI”).

(b) To amend paragraph 1 of Article VI of the 2002 Agreement as follows:

“6.1 The GS/OAS area with responsibility for coordinating GS/OAS activities under this Agreement is the Department of Human Development, and the Coordinator is Jeanelle van GlaanenWeygel, Senior Specialist. The University area with responsibility for coordinating cooperation activities under this Agreement is the Institute for the Study of Latin America and the Caribbean, and the Coordinator is Professor Jorge Nef, Director. (c) To replace paragraphs 1 and 2 of Article VII of the 2002 Agreement with the following:

“7.1 This Amendment No.1 to the 2002 Agreement shall come into force as of the date of signature by the authorized representatives of the Parties and shall remain in force until it is terminated in accordance with the provisions of Article 7.2, below.

7.2 This Amendment No.1 to the 2002 Agreement may be terminated by mutual agreement or may be terminated by either Party without cause upon

no less than 30 days' written notice to the other Party. However, such termination shall have no effect upon any supplementary agreements, memoranda of understanding, and/or letters exchanged as the Parties may have signed for the implementation of programs, projects and/or activities under the provisions of Article IV of the 2002 Agreement for which financing has been duly provided. Such agreements, memoranda and/or letters shall remain in force for the life thereof unless the duly authorized representatives of the Parties mutually otherwise so decide.

(d). All other terms and conditions of the January 22, 2002 Agreement as amended by this Amendment No.1 that are not inconsistent with the provisions of this Amendment No.1 remain unchanged and are in full force and effect.


