# CONTRIBUTION AGREEMENT AMENDMENT CANADA/CICAD 2007-2008

No. 1

Issued under Treasury Board Authority: 831370 of May 10, 2004

This Amendment is made between Her Majesty the Queen in right of Canada, represented by Minister of Foreign Affairs (hereinafter referred to as "Department of Foreign Affairs and International Trade (DFAIT))" and

The General Secretariat of the Organization of American States herein represented by the Executive Secretariat of the Inter-American Drug Abuse Control Commission of the Organization of American States (hereinafter referred to as "ES/CICAD" or the "Institution"),

DFAIT and the **Institution** agree to amend the Contribution Agreement, dated as of the 30<sup>th</sup> day of July, 2007, as follows:

- 1. Sub-Paragraph 2.1, page 2
- 2.1 Subject to the provisions of this Contribution Agreement, DFAIT will make a contribution ("the Contribution") to the ES/CICAD for deposit in its Specific Fund to finance ES/CICAD activities in the sum of CAD \$900,000 (nine hundred thousand Canadian dollars), as follows:

2.1 Subject to the provisions of this Contribution Agreement, DFAIT will make a contribution ("the Contribution") to the ES/CICAD for deposit in its Specific Fund to finance ES/CICAD activities in the sum of CAD \$1,000,000 (one million Canadian dollars), as follows:

# 2. Sub-Paragraph 3.1, page 3

3.1 Subject to the provisions of Annex A to this Contribution Agreement, DFAIT shall provide the contribution of CAD \$900,000 (nine hundred thousand Canadian dollars) to the ES/CICAD in reimbursement based on receipts from the ES/CICAD of expenditure of the funds. An initial payment of up to CAD \$625,000 (six hundred and twenty-five thousand Canadian dollars) will be provided upon receipt of documentation which demonstrates that the ES/CICAD requires reimbursement of expenses incurred in implementing the Project. DFAIT will retain final payment for the remaining amount, until receipt of narrative and financial reports on the use of the whole contribution.

#### To be replaced by:

3.1 Subject to the provisions of Annex A to this Contribution Agreement, DFAIT shall provide the contribution of CAD \$1,000,000 (one million Canadian dollars) to the ES/CICAD in reimbursement based on receipts from the ES/CICAD of expenditure of the funds. An initial payment of up to CAD \$625,000 (six hundred and twenty-five thousand Canadian dollars) will be provided upon receipt of documentation which demonstrates that the ES/CICAD requires reimbursement of expenses incurred in implementing the Project. DFAIT will retain final payment for the remaining amount, until receipt of narrative and financial reports on the use of the whole contribution.

# 3. Annex "A": Undertakings by the Institution, page 11

**Note:** Funding under this Contribution Agreement will cover the period from the 1<sup>st</sup> day of April, 2007 to the 31<sup>st</sup> day of March, 2008.

- ii) Synthetic Drug Production and Trafficking (Colombia) up to CAD \$50,000
- iii) International Observer Attachment Program (Ottawa) up to CAD \$50,000
- iv) Advanced Drug Investigation and Interdiction Techniques (Peru) up to CAD \$50,000
- v) Advanced Drug Investigation and Interdiction Techniques (Bahamas) up to CAD \$60,000
- vi) Advanced Drug Investigation and Interdiction Techniques (Haiti) up to CAD \$50,000
- vii) Advanced Drug Investigation and Interdiction Techniques (Dominican Republic) up to CAD \$40,000
- viii) Evaluation of Youth Substance Abuse Prevention Programs CAD \$50,000
- ix) International Capacity-Building Program for Latin American Health Professionals up to CAD \$150,000

The Institution will submit a report to the Department of Foreign Affairs and International Trade on the results of these financial expenditures in accordance with the provisions of this Agreement.

**Note:** Funding under this Contribution Agreement will cover the period from the 1<sup>st</sup> day of April, 2007 to the 31<sup>st</sup> day of March, 2008.

Based on funding requirements notified to the Government of Canada by the Institution, the Institution will ensure that the Canadian contribution will be distributed as set out below (all figures in Canadian dollars):

- (a) the sum of CAD \$311,000 (three hundred eleven thousand dollars) as general funding to be used to fund operations of the Institution and cover corresponding professional / administrative services and indirect cost in accordance to GS/OAS General Standards and Budgetary and Financial Rules and Regulations; and
- (b) the sum of up to CAD \$689,000 (six hundred eighty nine thousand dollars) as funding in support of the following initiatives:
- i) Support for the Multilateral Evaluation Mechanism (MEM) process up to CAD \$235,500
- ii) Synthetic Drug Production and Trafficking (Colombia) up to CAD \$10,000
- iii) International Observer Attachment Program (Ottawa) up to CAD \$50,000
- iv) Advanced Drug Investigation and Interdiction Techniques (Peru) up to CAD \$33,000
- v) Advanced Drug Investigation and Interdiction Techniques (Bahamas) **up to CAD \$34,000**
- vi) Advanced Drug Investigation and Interdiction Techniques (Haiti) up to CAD \$30,000
- vii) Advanced Drug Investigation and Interdiction Techniques (Dominican Republic) up to CAD \$55,000
- viii) Evaluation of Youth Substance Abuse Prevention Programs up to CAD \$27,000
- ix) International Capacity-Building Program for Latin American Health Professionals up to CAD \$150,000
- x) Major Case Management Sleipner (Colombia) up to CAD \$33,500
- xi) Major Case Management Sleipner (Jamaica) up to CAD \$31,000

The Institution will submit a report to the Department of Foreign Affairs and International Trade on the results of these financial expenditures in accordance with the provisions of this Agreement.
