The Fourth Course of the Committee on Juridical and Political Affairs on International Humanitarian Law (organized jointly by the OAS Department of International Law and the International Committee of the Red Cross) will take place on **Thursday January 28, 2010, in the Padilha Vidal Room, 1889 F. St. N.W., Washington D.C.** The Course, convened by General Assembly Resolution AG/RES. 2507, is designed specifically for members of OAS Permanent Missions and General Secretariat, providing a basic introduction to the principal norms on IHL and to the rules regulating means and methods of warfare, and in particular the application of IHL to armed conflict and other situations of violence.
