Mr. Ravier is the Protection Coordinator at the ICRC delegation in Colombia. In this capacity, he is in charge of all protection activities undertaken by the ICRC throughout the country (relating to Visits to Detainees, Re-establishing Family Links, the search for Missing Persons and Protection of the Civilian Population).

Guilhem Ravier graduated in International Law at the Universities of Bordeaux (France) and Warwick (UK), and in Politics at the University of Bordeaux. He then completed a master degree in Emergency Humanitarian Aid with specialisation in IHL from the University of Aix-en-Provence (France). After leaving university, Mr. Ravier completed his compulsory military service in 1999-2000, serving in the CIMIC department of the French Armed Forces' General Headquarters and then in Bosnia and Herzegovina as liaison officer with UNHCR for the NATO-lead International Stabilisation Force (SFOR). He went on to work with UNHCR in Bosnia and joined the ICRC in 2001. Before his current assignment to Colombia, he's worked on ICRC missions in Colombia, Liberia, Afghanistan, Guinea (Conakry), Indonesia and Iraq (these three last missions also as Protection Coordinator), and at ICRC headquarters (at the Protection Division, the Legal Division and the International Organisations' Division).
