

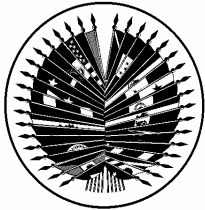


NOTICE

OAS/ICRC COURSE ON INTERNATIONAL HUMANITARIAN LAW

The OAS Office of International Law and the International Committee of the Red Cross have the pleasure of inviting interested practitioners, academics and students to the Second Course on International Humanitarian Law of the OAS Committee on Juridical and Political Affairs. The Course will take place on January 24, 2008, at the Padilla Vidal Hall of the OAS GSB Building located at 1889 F. St. N.W. Washington D.C. The Course, convened by General Assembly Resolution AG/RES. 2293 will provide students with an introduction to the Geneva Conventions and Protocols, the protection of civilians in armed conflicts, application and enforcement of IHL, the role of the ICRC in current conflicts, and IHL in the Inter-American System. The course will be held in English and Spanish with available simultaneous interpretation. (For a detailed curriculum of the course, see document CP/CAJP-2541/07 Rev.1 attached to this notice).
