Entry and Exit formalities for Mexico

As from May 1st 2010, foreigners of any nationality who arrive in Mexico, whether as tourists, transmigrants or visitor business persons, will be accepted in the Mexican

National Territory if they are holders of a valid and current visa issued by the Government of the United States of America. The same will apply for tourists, transmigrants or visitor business persons arriving in Mexico with a flight carrier departing from the United States of America, presenting their valid and current passport as well as their boarding ticket and the Mexican migratory form (FMM) given by the transporting air company.

Notwithstanding the foregoing, it is the responsibility of each participant to check with the embassies or consular offices of Mexico in their countries, the requirements for obtaining visas set by the Government of Mexico. For such purposes we advise participants to consult the website <http://www.sre.gob.mx/servicios/visas/extran.htm#2> . The Government of Mexico does NOT grant visas on arrival at airports.

Weather

In September the average temperature in Mexico ranges from 57°F (14°C) to 79°F (26°C).

Electric Current

Electric current in Mexico is 110 volts.

Local Transfers

It is recommended to only use taxi services from the International Airport of Mexico City, whose office is located immediately outside the customs area within the airport building itself. The distance from International Airport to the hotel is 9.3 miles, about 30 minutes. The price per trip is around US\$ 17.00
