We are pleased to invite you to participate in the Best Practices Forum of the Americas on the application of Information and Communication Technologies (ICT's) for Natural Disaster Mitigation. The Executive Secretariat for Integral Development (SEDI) of the General Secretariat of the OAS, through the Department of Sustainable Development, is organizing the sixth edition of the Best Practices Forum of the Americas on Natural Disaster Mitigation with the aspiration of "Reaching most vulnerable communities and sectors: Connecting High Technology Information Systems with Community-based Information and Communication Systems". The objective of the Forum is to promote the exchange of consolidated practices and lessons learned through interaction over the Internet.

In the first online session, Mr. Ronald Jackson, General Director of the Office of Disaster Preparedness and Emergency Management (ODPEM) of Jamaica, will present the Jamaica's experience on ICT's applications as an alternative source of information. This session will be held on **Wednesday, June 6, 2007, at 3:00 p.m. EST** (Washington D.C. time).



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In two other subsequent sessions, the following themes will be presented at the Forum:

- Peru's experience in the implementation of Educational Rural Networks for Disaster Prevention.
- Central America's experience in the introduction of ICT's to coordinate the operations of the National Emergency Centers.
