Isabel Calle Valladares is the Director of the Policy and Environmental Management Program of the Peruvian Society of Environmental Law, which was established in 1998. She studied law at the Pontificia Universidad Católica del Perú (PUCP), where she obtained a specialized Certificate of Environmental Management. In the period of 2000-2006, Ms Calle was actively involved in designing the normative environmental framework in Peru and lead the public consultation process for the establishment of the current Peruvian General Environmental Law. She also has significant experience in the area of local and regional environmental management mechanisms, and has participated in concrete environmental management initiatives in locations including Huarney, Carhuaz, Huarz, and Pacasmavo, among others. As part of her professional activities, Ms Calle has led the processes of identifying, systematizing, and monitoring the impact of public participation processes in Peru and has analyzed the environmental and regulatory effect of free trade agreements on the Peruvian forestry and textile sector.
