Juan Carlos Espinosa is an Industrial Engineer from Universidad de los Andes in Bogotá, Colombia, and has a Masters Degree in Environmental Management from Yale University. He currently works with World Wildlife Fund (WWF) in Colombia as a coordinator for the Environmental Policy Division. His responsibilities include the follow-up of infrastructure megaprojects in priority areas of the eco-regional complexes of the Northern Andes, Choco-Darien, the Orinoco Basin and Colombian Amazon; promotion of tools for sector planning with environmental criteria, particularly in palm oil and biofuel sectors; and the promotion of schemes for payments for environmental services. Prior to joining WWF, Mr Espinosa worked with the National Planning Department of Colombia in themes related to environmental and planning indicators, follow-up and assessment of regional environmental management, as well as in the Center of Industrial Ecology of Yale University in themes related to industrial eco-parks.
