


REEEP

- Renewable Energy and Energy Efficiency Partnership
- 1. REEEP is a multi-stakeholder Type II partnership launched by the UK government at the WSSD, committed to accelerating the uptake of **renewable energy** and **energy efficiency**
- 2. REEEP currently comprises 224 partners representing **38 governments**, businesses and NGO's.
- 3. REEEP is currently funded by various governments such as Australia, Austria, Germany, EU, Ireland, Italy, Norway, the Netherlands, New Zealand, Spain, US, and UK.





Composition of the REEEP Partnership








REEEP's Vision and Focus

- •6.36 million € REEEP Contribution and 23.3 Million leverage




The total REEEP project portfolio is well balanced in terms of thematic and sectoral objectives
