In their determination to strengthen the institutional capacities of the Member States through initiatives which focus upon cooperation and technical assistance, the National Police of Colombia and the General Secretariat of the Organization of American States will convene a training course entitled **Management of Police Intelligence** which will take place in Bogota from September 26 to 30, 2011.

This activity forms part of the **Inter-American Police Training Program (PICAP)** which has been offered by the OAS since 2006.

Police Management is one of the five pillars which form part of the Commitment to Public Security in the Americas, adopted at the First Meeting of Ministers of Public Security in the Americas (MISPA) which took place in Mexico City (2008).

The National Police of Colombia will share its experiences in the management, collection and analysis of police intelligence. The Course will additionally provide an opportunity for the exchange of knowledge amongst the participating countries through presentations that focus upon different experiences and lessons learned.

The Course has been designed to benefit police officials whom are responsible for or connected to the fields of management and analysis of intelligence.

The OAS General Secretariat is able to offer a limited quantity of grants for police officials who meet selection criteria. The grants cover air tickets whilst the National Police of Colombia will cover the cost of accommodation, meals and internal transport.
