## 1. Venue of the General Assembly:

The forty-fifth regular session of the General Assembly of the Organization of American States will be held from June 15-16, 2015, in Washington, D.C. The sessions will be held in the Hall of the Americas in the OAS Main Building, located at the corner of 17<sup>th</sup> Street and Constitution, N.W., Washington, D.C., 20006, United States of America.

Late registration for official delegations and the **delivery of identification cards** will be done starting on June 12, 2015 in the TL-76 Room at the OAS General Secretariat Building, **1889 F Street, NW, Washington, DC 20006**: On Friday, June 12 from 9:00 a.m. to 5:30 p.m.; on Saturday, June 13 from 10:00 a.m. to 2:00pm; on Sunday, June 14 from 8:00 a.m. to 1:00 p.m.; and June 15 and 16, from 8:30 a.m. to 4:30 p.m.

For security reasons, I.D.s will be required for all General Assembly activities. The delegations and other participants are asked kindly to present a copy of their official credentials when registering.

## 7. Working languages and documents:

The General Assembly working meetings will be conducted in the official languages of the Organization: Spanish, English, French and Portuguese, for all of which simultaneous interpretation will be provided. Since greening measures will be in effect and **the printing of documents will be limited**, participants are requested to keep their documents during all meetings.
