#### **1. Venue of the General Assembly**

The forty-eighth regular session of the General Assembly of the Organization of American States (OAS) will be held at OAS headquarters in Washington, D.C., on June 4 and 5, 2018. The meetings will take place in the Hall of the Americas of the OAS Main Building, located at the corner of 17th Street and Constitution Avenue, NW, Washington, D.C.

Official delegations may collect ID cards and undergo late registration from May 31, 2018, in Room TL-76 of the General Services Building located at **1889 F Street, NW, Washington, D.C. 20006**, at the following times:

May 31 to June 1: 9:00 a.m. to 5:30 p.m.

June 2 to 4: 8:00 a.m. to 5:30 p.m.

June 5: 8:00 a.m. to 1:00 p.m.

For security reasons, the IDs will be required for access to all General Assembly activities. The delegations and other participants are asked kindly to present a copy of their official credentials when registering.

**7. Working languages and documents**

The General Assembly working meetings will be conducted in the official languages of the Organization: Spanish, English, French, and Portuguese, for all of which simultaneous interpretation will be provided. Since greening measures will be in effect and **printing of documents will be limited**, participants are requested to keep their documents during all meetings.
