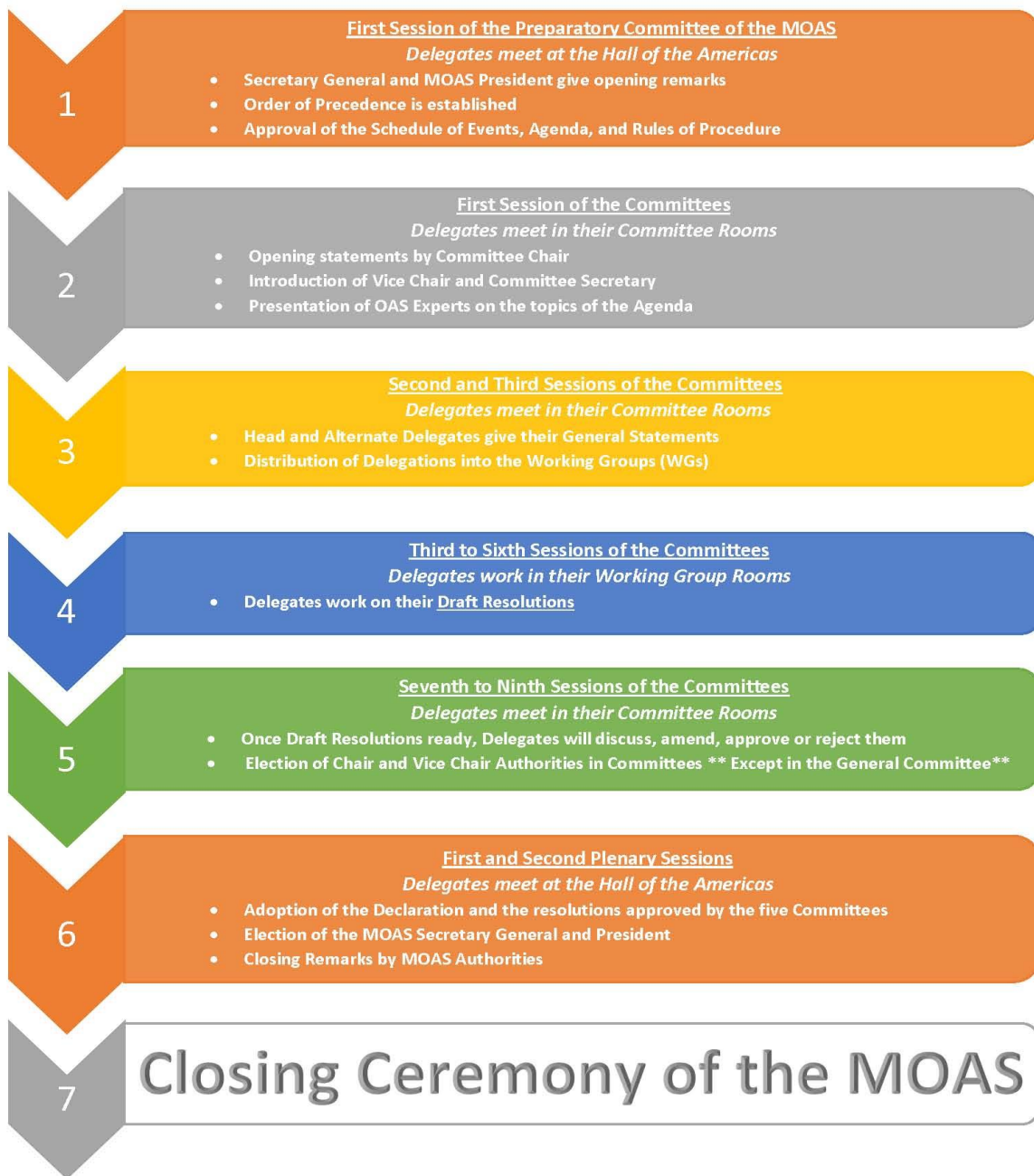

GENERAL DYNAMICS OF THE MOAS FOR HIGH SCHOOLS





MOAS Committees are the basic work units of the MOAS. Delegates are divided into five committees: General, Juridical and Political Affairs, Hemispheric Security, Inter-American Council for Integral Development – CIDI; and Administrative and Budgetary Affairs.

Heads and Alternates Delegates give their general statements in the Committees, during the Second and Third Session of the Committees respectively.

During the committee sessions, delegates meet in their respective working groups to debate and discuss current issues of the inter-American agenda; to draft resolutions on these issues, and to present them for approval to the corresponding committee.

After the first session and the installation of the Preparatory Committee of the MOAS General Assembly, the sessions of the five (5) committees take place. These committees will meet in their conference rooms and will establish their working groups.

Each working group will draft one resolution. These resolutions will be approved (or rejected) in each of the Committees and, afterwards, they will be adopted in the MOAS General Assembly (last day of the MOAS.)
