6 WRITE YOUR GENERAL STATEMENT FOR PRESENTATION **

Excerpt from Position Paper to be presented orally during the first session of the committees. Include the aspect(s) of your topic to be proposed. You may want to include what your country has done about it. Justify your proposal (1 minute max.).

5 WRITE A POSITION PAPER *

Include your findings, country position, proposals and highlights on your topic (3 pages approx). This document is for your own use.

4 ANALYSIS AND CRITICAL THINKING

Analyze all the data gathered. Structure your ideas and proposals following your assigned country's standpoint.

3 UNDERSTAND THE POSITION OF YOUR ASSIGNED COUNTRY REGARDING YOUR TOPIC

Contact the Permanent Mission of your assigned country to the OAS to get information.

2 READ ABOUT YOUR COMMITTEE TOPIC

Use the "List of Reference Documents" published in the MOAS/PC web page.

1 CONDUCT A GENERAL RESEARCH ABOUT YOUR ASSIGNED COUNTRY

Political system, location, economy, main industries, and role of your assigned country in the region

* If two (2) or more delegates are representing one (1) country in the same Committee, a team effort is required to complete this step.

** If two (2) or more delegates are representing one (1) country in the same Committee, each delegate will present a General Statement on a different perspective of the topic.
