
ITEN Virtual Seminar 2021

Attendees and presenters joined the Seminar via the interactive Gather. Town platform.


Each person created a digital avatar that moved around in the 2-D space, allowing for one-on-one interaction as well as small group, and whole group conversations.

Participants visited exhibition spaces where they learned about open access resources for STEM education, including courses offered by ITEN partners.








Workshops took place in various formats, including whole group conversations, small group work, individual computer laboratories, demonstrations, and lectures.


