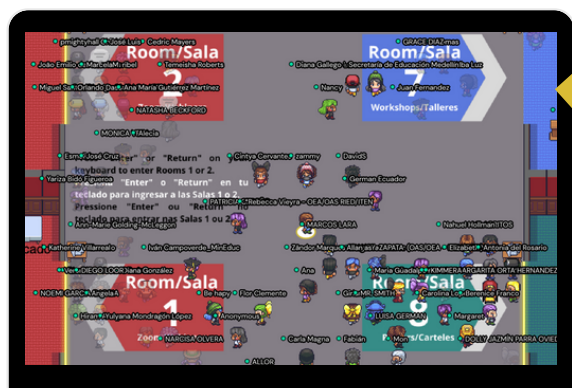


ITEN Virtual Seminar 2021

The ITEN Virtual Seminar was held on **August 27 and 28, 2021**. This two-day event was composed of simultaneous **webinars** showcasing the work of Project Teams, hands-on **workshops**, and a **poster session** presented by teachers, teacher educators, ministry officials, and other educational stakeholders from across the world. Presentations were available in three languages: **English, Portuguese, and Spanish**.

All sessions addressed **practices, programs, and policies** that support STEM teachers.

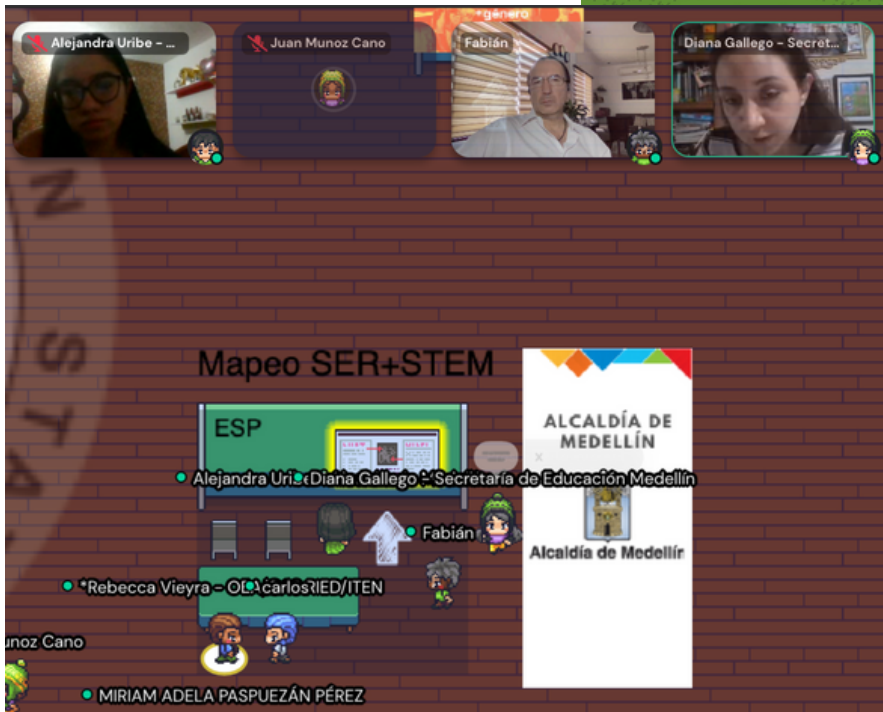


Attendees and presenters joined the Seminar via the interactive Gather.Town platform.

Participants visited exhibition spaces where they learned about open access resources for STEM education, including courses offered by ITEN partners.

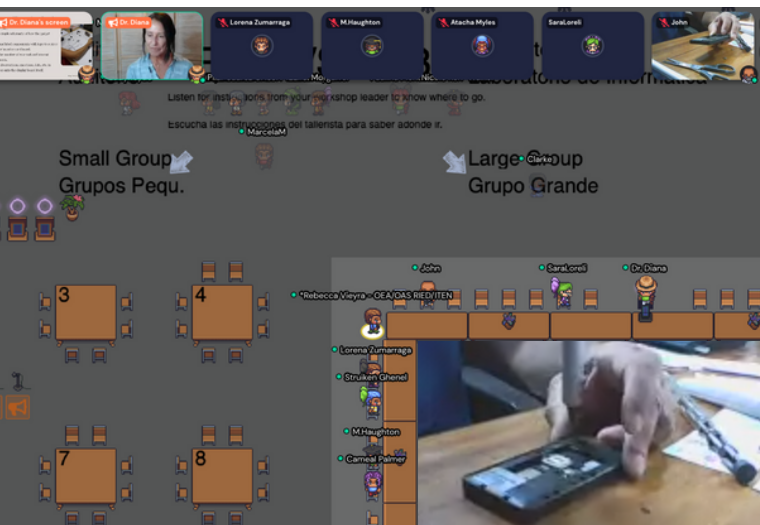
