On 10 March 2021, Fairfax County Public Schools (FCPS) of Virginia, USA and the National Ministry of Education of Colombia held an orientation session for matched teachers for the *Global Classroom* and *Connecting Cultures* projects.

Supported by an agreement between FCPS and the OAS, this effort connections 15 teachers from the FCPS' *Global Classroom Project* with 15 teachers from the National Ministry of Education of Colombia's *Connecting Cultures* project.

Country Focus: Colombia and USA

> The shared vision of these initiatives is to support teachers to "**establish relationships** with colleagues in which they will **collaborate** to plan **meaningful learning experiences** for their students, develop **intercultural competence**, and engage in **jobembedded professional development**."

Over the period of five weeks, teachers will collaborate around one of the UN Sustainable Development Goals to develop a collaborate project in which both their students as well as their matched partner's students from the other country will collaborate.
