
## Country in Focus: Republic Republic



Sandra Guerrero, ITEN Teacher Fellow, is creating a new physics teaching community across the Dominican Republic.




As part of the obligation of the ITEN Teacher Fellowship, teachers carry out a leadership plan that significantly impacts at least 20 other colleagues. To do so, **Sandra created a virtual network**, connected initially through WhatsApp.

In this group, teachers provide general support to their peers and share specific content related to STEM.

Aiming to reach her peers in a more formal and structured setting, Sandra started a series of virtual workshops with international guest speaker specialists on themes that range from introduction to STEM to project-based learning.

The teachers, who normally would not have access to this opportunity, reacted very positively to the initiative, and are already implementing some of the learning in their classrooms.



On February 8, 2021, **60** classroom physics teachers participated in the first workshop.



Sandra intends to continue organizing virtual webinars and conferences. These activities are just a first step toward helping her to strengthen the physics teacher education in the Dominican Republic.
