

Country in Focus: Guatemala and United States

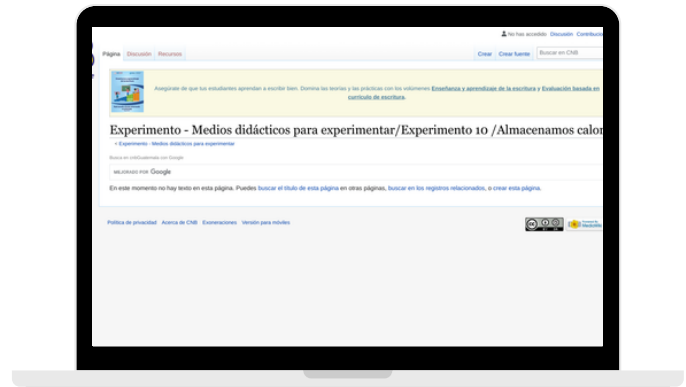
The ITEN Project Team composed of the **Online Learning Initiative** of the **United States**, the **Vitruvian Consulting / Punto Crea** of **Guatemala**, and the **Universidad del Valle de Guatemala**, is working to recognize and expand the availability and access to **STEAM Open Educational Resources (OERs)**.

Focused on identifying existing good quality STEAM OERs, aligning them with the National Base Curriculum of Guatemala, the Team also plans to develop a teacher training module to strengthen the capacity for development and use of STEAM resources locally in Guatemala.

The resources will be available on the platforms: **cnbGuatemala.org**, aimed mainly at teachers, and **puntocrea.org**, aimed at tutors and young participants in non-formal education processes.

The Team aspires to continue working together aligning resources, training teachers on their use, and seeking to replicate the experience in other contexts and with more partners.
