

**Bhagya Malladi**, a Jamaican teacher and recipient of an **ITEN Teacher Leadership Fund**, implemented a mentoring program to help **primary school teachers integrate STREAM** into their teaching and become leaders themselves.



This project included multiple sessions in late 2020 and early 2021 about STREAM. The teachers then build their own STREAM lesson plan by using a template.

On April 8 & 9, the seven participating teachers led a showcase of the lessons they developed and implemented, including resulting student work.

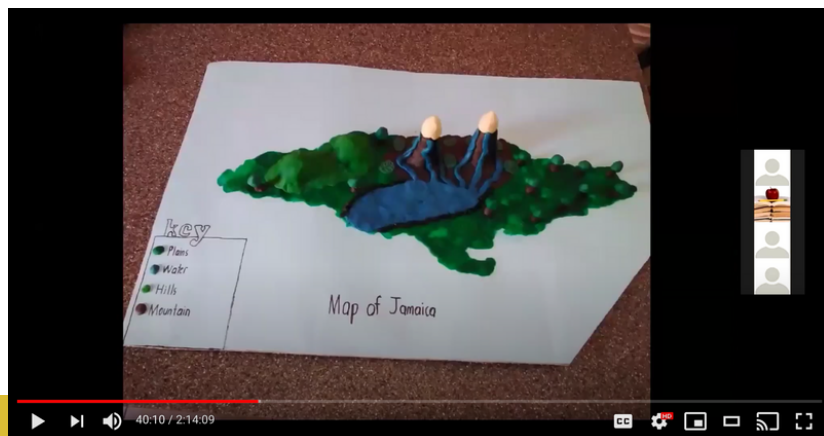
