

WHO
Can apply?

International students from Latin America or the Caribbean enrolled in their last two years of undergraduate or graduate programs at accredited universities in the United States.

For 75 years, the Rowe Fund has proudly fulfilled Dr. Rowe's vision to contribute to the human development of citizens of OAS member States by granting

interest-free student loans.

HOW Much can I receive? Up to \$15,000 dollars in **interest-free** student loan(s) to be repaid in 50 installments, three months after completion of studies.
