WHO

Can apply?

Students from **Latin America or the Caribbean (F-1 or J-1 visa holders)** who have been admitted or are currently pursuing advanced training, research, graduate, or the last two years of undergraduate studies in U.S. universities.

For 70 years, the Rowe Fund has proudly fulfilled Dr. Rowe’s vision to contribute to the human development of citizens of OAS member States by granting interest-free student loans.

Dr. Rowe devoted a large part of his life fostering understanding and integration among the American nations, demonstrating a special interest in the education of Latin American and Caribbean youth whom he assisted during his lifetime and to whom he bequeathed a legacy in his will.

HOW

Much is the loan for?

Up to \$15,000 **interest-free** student loan in total during the course of your studies to be repaid in 50 installments, three months after completion of studies.

WHEN

Is the deadline to apply?

There are **no deadlines**. Applications are received and reviewed on a year-round basis and at any time during your studies in the U.S.

WHAT

Is our Vision?

To invest in highly qualified individuals, capable of applying the benefit of their education for the development of their countries.

By financing a portion of the studies in the U.S., the Rowe Fund helps students complete their education while fostering cultural diversity and communication among the people of the Americas.
