

WHC Can apply?

Students from Latin America or the Caribbean (F-1 or J-1 visa holders) who have been admitted or are currently pursuing advanced training, research, graduate, or the last two years of undergraduate studies in U.S. universities.

For 70 years, the Rowe Fund has proudly fulfilled Dr. Rowe's vision to contribute to the human development of citizens of OAS member States by granting interest-free student loans.

Much is the loan for?

Up to \$15,000 interest-free student loan in total during the course of your studies to be repaid in 50 installments, three months after completion of studies.

Dr. Rowe devoted a large part of his life fostering understanding and integration among the American nations, demonstrating a special interest in the education of Latin American and Caribbean youth whom he assisted during his lifetime and to whom he bequeathed a legacy in his will.

Is the deadline to

apply?

There are **no deadlines**. Applications are received and reviewed on a year-round basis and at any time during your studies in the U.S.
