II. ABOUT THE SCHOLARSHIP

1. Financial Responsibility of the Scholarship Recipients:

- The remaining cost of tuition and mandatory fees of the study program
- Living expenses and accommodation, medical insurance, enrollment fee, books and study materials.
- Roundtrip air tickets.
- Visa arrangements (IE will provide support for this through its Student Office).
- Participants will also be responsible to cover: student services fees (certifications, diploma fees, graduation fees, etc.), and any other expenses not included in the scholarship.

2. Elegibility Requirements:

- To be eligible to apply for the scholarship, the candidate must have completed the admission process to the program and must have received admission to the study program.
- To be eligible, candidates must be nationals and/or permanent legal residents of any of the OAS Member States.
- Applicants who are Staff members of the General Secretariat, persons under performance contracts with the General Secretariat, staff members of the permanent missions to the OAS, and their relatives are not eligible for OAS scholarships.

3. Scholarship Application Process:

The deadlines for applicants to complete and submit the OAS Scholarship Application Form are the following:

- For table No.1 the deadline to apply is February 11th, 2013
- For table No.2 the deadline to apply is March 8th, 2013
- For table No.3 the deadline to apply is April 29th, 2013
- For table No.4 the deadline to apply is May 20th, 2013

 - Completed OAS Scholarship Application Form
 - Copy of the transcripts of the latest degree obtained
 - Updated CV (1 page in the language in which the Study Program will be taught)

• Essay (max. 500 words per essay / font Times New Roman No. 12 /line spacing 1.5) describing how the professional development program will directly impact your career; improves their professional skills in their current job or to allow access to one.

4. Scholarship selection criteria:

- The overall academic and professional merit of the candidate.
- The candidate's potential impact upon completion of the course of study and return to the country of origin.
- An extensive and equitable geographic distribution for the benefit of all Member States that takes into account the greater needs of the smaller and relatively less developed economies.
- The economic need of the applicant, according to what is indicated in the essays.

5. Evaluation Criteria:

The following evaluation criteria will be considered in the selection of candidates:

- ✓ Academic profile.
- ✓ Financial Need.
- ✓ Geographical, cultural and gender diversity.
- ✓ Availability of full-time study program.
- ✓ Intention to return to a member state of the OAS or work in an international organization.
- ✓ Work experience relevant to the field of study.
- ✓ Availability of financial resources to cover the rest of the program costs not covered by the scholarship.
- ✓ IE Results (aptitude and English language proficiency if the program is taught in English only).
- ✓ Participation in social projects.

6. Responsibilities of the Scholarship Recipients:

- a) Selected candidates must sign the completed "Acceptance of the Scholarship Award Form" and return it to the DHDEC by email (lserranop@oas.org) and refrain from activities that are inconsistent with the status of an OAS scholarship recipient and abide by all regulations set out in the form.
- b) Comply with the above-mentioned provisions set forth in the Financial Responsibilities of the Scholarship Recipient (II.2).
- c) Comply with all the academic guidelines and admission requirements requested by IE and submit to the updates of these guidelines and requirements made by the academic authorities at IE.
- d) The scholarship recipient must not fail any subjects of the program.
- e) The recipient must obtain the necessary visa(s) to travel to Spain, or any other country where the program will take place, and cover all related any related costs. (The student may contact IE to obtain support in this regard).
- f) The scholarship may be declined by the scholarship recipient before the start of the program of study without financial penalties. However, if the scholarship recipient declines the scholarship after the start of the study program without a compelling proof or reason, the scholarship recipient shall reimburse the total amount of the scholarship costs to the OAS or to IE of any monies disbursed up until the declination. In addition, the scholarship recipient shall inform the

- DHDEC with at least one week before the program's start date in case he cannot begin the study program, in order for the scholarship to be offered to the next candidate in the order of merit.
- g) Students who benefit from these grants must agree to return to work in one of the OAS member countries or at an international organization for a minimum period equal to the duration of the scholarship. Failure to comply with this commitment, the beneficiary must return to IE for the total value of the endowment granted.
