Selected master's candidates will be required to apply through the online system of VUB after accepting the educational offer.

Student/Applicant's profile

- ✓ Holder of a university degree. Having a university degree does NOT automatically mean you will be admitted as a graduate student. The admission can be subjected to a preliminary examination and an investigation into the applicant's suitability.
- ✓ The ultimate decision about the eligibility for graduate study resides with the Faculty in which the studies will take place.
- ✓ Good command of English language
- ✓ Excellent academic credentials

Admission Process:

- ✓ Before applying for this educational opportunity, students are encouraged to read the program's description, and ensure that the study area fulfills their expectations and interests¹.

- ✓ Applicants must have a bachelor's degree to apply for a master's degree program.

▼ EXPENSES NOT COVERED

FINANCIAL RESPONSIBILITY OF RECIPIENTS

- ✓ Tuition of 890-2950 EUR, if not among the top selected for a tuition fee waiver.
- ✓ Annual administration fee; estimated a 105€
- ✓ Immigration fees, estimated at €100
- ✓ Settling-in fees, estimated at €500
- ✓ Living expenses, estimated at €1000 per month
- ✓ Visa charge, estimated at €250
- ✓ Health insurance; estimated at 427€ (taxes excluded) per year
- ✓ Travel expenses
- ✓ Any other costs not mentioned.

- ✓ These above expenses listed as financial responsibility shall be the sole and exclusive responsibility of the recipients and the recipients will be responsible for all costs not covered by this educational opportunity.
- ✓ The benefits are subject to the academic performance of the recipient. In order to receive these benefits, the recipient should not be reported with an unsatisfactory academic performance due to absences or failing courses.

▼ ELIGIBILITY

To be considered for this educational opportunity, an applicant must:

- Submit a complete application with all required supporting documents; and
- Be a citizen and/or permanent legal resident of any [OAS member state](#).

The following applicants are ineligible:

- ⊗ Current OAS recipients;
- ⊗ GS/OAS staff and their immediate relatives or GS/OAS consultants; and
- ⊗ OAS Permanent officials and their immediate relatives.

▼ SELECTION CRITERIA

- ✓ The merits and overall credentials of the candidate, including his/her academic and professional background;
- ✓ Geographical distribution of the applicants, taking into account the greater needs of the smaller and relatively less developed economies;
- ✓ Applicants whose essays portray the highest potential for impact upon return to their countries of origin; and
- ✓ Gender diversity.

▼ SELECTION PROCESS:

Selection Committee VUB and the OAS will select the awardees, based on the [criteria](#) listed above. The names of the awardees will be published in June 2018 at www.oas.org/scholarships.

Notification of selected candidates The OAS will contact selected candidates by email with the educational offer and instructions for the acceptance form. **Applicants who are not selected will not be contacted.**

▼ DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITY OF THE RECIPIENT:

- ✓ The educational opportunity will be formally awarded only after the selected awardees have signed the Acceptance Form to formally accept the educational offer and agree to its terms and conditions.
- ✓ Applicants should take at least 6 weeks into account for their visa to be processed. Candidates will be required to show proof of sufficient funds to cover the expenses from a guarantor during the visa application process.
- ✓ Refrain from activities that are inconsistent with the status of an OAS recipient, abiding by the regulations referred to in this Acceptance Form.
- ✓ Comply with all the academic guidelines and admission requirements requested by VUB and submit to the updates of these guidelines and requirements made by the academic authorities at VUB.
- ✓ Comply with the provisions indicated in the "Financial responsibilities of awardees."
- ✓ To retain the educational offer, OAS recipients should not have low academic performance (GPA must be at least 3.0/4.0), due to absence from the program and/or course failure.
- ✓ The educational offer can be declined by the recipient before the start date of the program of study without financial penalties. However, if she/he declines the educational offer after that date without proof of force majeure, the OAS and VUB may require the recipient to reimburse all funding granted to her/him with the offer.
- ✓ Commitment to return to work in their sponsoring country or permanent legal residence; in one of the OAS Member States; or at an international organization for at least the length of the duration of the educational opportunity. Failure to comply with this commitment, the GS/OAS and/or VUB could seek reimbursement for the total value of the educational opportunity awarded.
