Background:

The Organization of American States (OAS), through the Government of Chile Scholarship and Training Project for CARICOM Countries, invited citizens of CARICOM member States to apply for scholarship consideration to participate in a Hazard Mitigation & Disaster Management Course offered at The University of Technology, Jamaica from November 4 – 10, 2018.

The Course attracted working professionals from the Caribbean with backgrounds or work-related duties in emergency management and disaster response, including first responders, firefighters, and emergency management personnel, policymakers, program directors, urban planners, NGOs, public health workers and practitioners from the private sector.

Scholarship Recipients and Benefits:

After a careful review of the merits and overall credentials of the candidates, including academic and professional background, and indicators of the highest potential for impact upon return to their countries of origin, the above twenty-five (25) Recipients were selected to receive the scholarship with benefits including;

- a) Full tuition and a one-time allowance to help defray the cost of meals, accommodation, local transportation, materials, and other incidentals for international participants, including Jamaicans residing outside of Kingston Jamaica; and
- b) Full tuition and a reduced one-time allowance to help defray the cost of meals, local transportation, materials, and other incidentals for Jamaicans residing in Kingston, Jamaica.

The Recipients are responsible for

- a) Round trip airfare, if applicable;
- b) Remaining cost of accommodation, meals, local transportation, and materials not met by the allowance;
- c) Visa and immigration charges, if applicable;
- d) Travel and health insurance, if applicable;
- e) Books and study materials; and
- f) Any additional costs that are not included in the OAS-UTech Jamaica Scholarship.
